PORTRAIT WORKSHOP: PAINTING LIKE THE OLD MASTER'S: Carin Hebenstreit (\$300). June 24, 25, & 26 or July 29, 30 & 31—, 9 AM—5 PM each day. Spanish classes at the Evendale Cultural Arts Center use games, chants, tongue-twisters, skits and songs, as well as paper-and-pencil exercises, to teach the basics of Spanish, the easiest language for English speakers to learn and practice. Students learn pronunciation, common phrases, themed vocabulary and listening comprehension, as well as basic reading and writing, through playing various versions of "Loteria" (traditional Mexican educational bingo), "La Pirinola" (spinning dredel-like game), and other fun activities.
