

2008 Evendale Men's Golf League

League play starts on Monday, April 21 and ends on August 25, 2008. **A banquet party will be held on August 27th at the Shelter House starting at 7:00 p.m. Mark your calendars.**

Please show up early for all matches if you can. Remember if you are late you may be holding up 3 other players. If you cannot play please call your partner.

Each player is responsible for obtaining a sub when he cannot show up for league play. The league has a sub list and you can arrange for a sub from that list, or you can have your own sub play for you.

PURPOSE-The purpose of this league is to get the men of Evendale playing golf, with exercise, good sportsmanship and fair play as its objective. The name of the game is RELAX.

LEAGUE- There will be three divisions this year. One division will play at the General Electric Golf Course and rotate front and back each week. Another division will play at Green Crest Golf Course rotating front and back. The third division will play at Glenview between the three nines. The Glenview division plays on Wednesdays, Green Crest and GE on Mondays.

STARTING TIME AT GREEN CREST IS 5:27 PM. FORFEIT TIME IS 6:05 PM.

STARTING TIME AT GENERAL ELECTRIC IS 5:30 PM. FORFEIT TIME IS 5:45 PM.

STARTING TIME AT GLENVIEW IS 5:26 PM. FORFEIT TIME IS 6:10 PM.

FEES Each golfer pays a \$25.00 league fee to the Recreation Department. If you play in two divisions the fee is \$43. This fee covers the banquet at the end of the season, prizes, gift certificates and secretaries' fees. **Please put due dates on your calendar!**

ONE-HALF OF THE GREENS FEES FOR THE SEASON ARE TO BE PAID BY APRIL 17TH. THE BALANCE OF THE GREENS FEES AND THE \$25.00 LEAGUE FEE ARE DUE ON JUNE 4TH. PAYMENT SCHEDULES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

AVERAGE SCORE AND HANDICAPPING

AVERAGES

A combination of the 2006 and 2007 scores will be used until five 2008 scores are recorded, as follows:

- 1st Week - average of all scores from 2004 (e.g. 40) = 40.0 average
- 2nd Week - shoot 38, plus four 40's = 198; $198/5 = 39.6$ average
- 3rd Week - shoot 43 + 38 + three 40's = 201; $201/5 = 40.2$ average
- 4th Week - shoot 47 + 43 + 38 + two 40's = 208; $208/5 = 41.6$ average
- 5th Week - shoot 42 + 47 + 43 + 38 + 40 = 210; $210/5 = 42.0$ average

The lowest five 2008 scores are used after 5 scores are recorded

SUBSTITUTE AVERAGE - a substitute will establish an average by using available scores from previous and current year, (including the current night's score) to compute the average before handicapping. The five lowest scores are used the remainder of the year.

Any average above 51 will be assigned a handicap of 18. Adjustment to Par - Three (3) strokes will be added to lower player's scratch score when playing the back nine - Par 27 - to figure handicap.

Closest to the Pin

Closest to the Pin money will be collected on the first night of play the 1st and 10th week of play. Secretaries will collect this \$18 at the golf course. Each course can choose to handle this differently.

PLAY AND SCORING

PLAY - Team and individual play will be on a 22 point system.

- A) Match play for 9 holes using 85% handicap. One point per hole - total 9 points.
- B) Medal play - gross score less handicap for the final 2 points. Match opponents - in all matches, low average man plays low average man.

NO SHOW SCORING

- A) When only 3 golfers show up, the single player plays full match against lowest handicap opponent. The second opponent receives an automatic two points medal and at least four match points. In this match the single players can only keep the second opponent from scoring more than 4 match points.
- B) When only 1 golfer from each team shows up they will play full match - max 11 points only. Single score only.
- C) When only 2 players from same team show they will receive as many as highest score that night. This includes rain no shows.
- D) When only 1 player shows in foursome that team will receive half as many points as any team scores that night.

OUT OF BOUNDS - If your first ball goes out of bounds, lay out two (2) club lengths from the out of bounds stakes or marker. Penalty ONE (1) STROKE. After hitting ball in a lake lay out across the lake with one stroke penalty. On holes with lateral water hazards, lay out no nearer hole, penalty 1 stroke.

LOST BALL - A ball should be dropped in the location of the lost ball. Penalty one (1) stroke.

IMPROVED LIE - You may improve your lie in the fairway, the rough or in the other fairway with the head of your club. You MAY NOT improve your lie in a sand trap.

SCORE CARDS - Each team is responsible for turning in its score cards completely filled out showing total score, points won and points lost. IF THE CARDS ARE NOT FILLED OUT COMPLETELY YOU WILL FORFEIT POINTS.

RAIN

All golfers must report to the Golf Course. Round is not canceled unless the course is closed. If round is played and your team does not show, your team will lose by forfeit. In case of inclement weather all must finish or round does not count. If it rains during play take cover but DO NOT LEAVE the course or club house without checking with the league secretary to see if the round is canceled. You may lose your match if play continues. (See No Show scoring previous page.)

CHAMPIONSHIP

The league winners from each division, Green Crest, General Electric and Glenview will be the secretaries the following year, will receive a league award and get half of their golf fees paid in 2009. Trophies for each league will be awarded to each course with winner's names engraved on each trophy!

The last night of play we have a 4-man scramble. Players must play at least 2 weeks to be eligible for this competition.

PRIZES

At the banquet, on August 27 at 7:00 p.m., there will be prizes awarded for 1) low gross each division, 2) most improved each division (must have played in our league last year), and 3) the championship team in each division.

To qualify for the low gross or most improved trophies you must not miss over 4 weeks of play.

Most improved - based on all scores played.

Low gross average - based on all scores played.
