I would like to wish everyone a happy New Year! 2008 already! I hope your family has made it through the holidays and you are looking forward to a healthy and happy 2008.

Please be considerate of your neighbors and our snow removal equipment during inclement weather. If you live on a narrow street or cul-de-sac be aware of the size of our snow plows and trucks that deliver salt for snow and ice control. If you can have your car off the street during snow and ice events that greatly aids our Service Department's ability to completely clear your street quickly and without coming in conflict with parked cars. When our crews do perform snow and ice control they always start with the primary streets, more precarious sections of streets and then work their way back to the residential streets. Our Service Department does their best to get all streets treated in a timely manner but depending on the weather conditions it may be later that your street gets treated. Be patient our Service folks always do their best.

Chipotle is scheduled to open in Evendale Commons on January 18<sup>th</sup>. You should see more 'grand opening' information on the website. Make a point of stopping by.

The Evendale Technical Center, a development by Al. Neyer, Inc., is going to be complete this spring. The development is the group of four new buildings behind Gold Star and Burger King. These are office condominiums targeted for the medical community or small office user. This is a great addition to the village.

The former Travelodge hotel across from St. Rita's was bought by the village in October of last year. We will be opening bids for the demolition of the building on January 8<sup>th</sup>. Removal of this problem property will be a welcome change. At the present time the village is going to demolish the building and consider what potential development is possible.

I would like to encourage anyone interested in the Comprehensive Master Plan process to make a note of Wednesday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>. The Committee is going to meet at 5:30pm on the 23<sup>rd</sup> to finalize their plan and forward it to the Planning Commission. The meeting will be held at the Recreation Building in the Adult Gathering Room.

Again, make a note, resident memberships to the Recreation facility for 2008 are on sale. Current resident members, stop by the Recreation Center front desk from 9am-9pm Mon-Fri. If you don't have a membership, stop by the Tax Office in the Administration building and register as a resident of Evendale, then stop by the Recreation Center to purchase your membership. Memberships are good for a calendar year so renew as soon as possible.

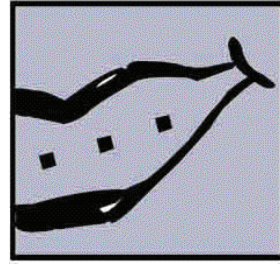
