By the time you receive this newsletter you should have received a postcard from CSI Waste Services regarding your trash and recycling collection. As you are aware, the Village contracts to have residential trash and recycling collected. In order to properly contract for this service, the Village publicly bids the work every 3 years. For the past many years Rumpke has been the lowest bidder, hence, you have seen Rumpke provide service to the Village for as long as I can remember. This year CSI Waste Service was low bidder. The Village confirmed that they met all bidding specifications and we will see a change in collection companies starting January 1, 2009.

A few notes that you need to be aware of to make this a smooth transition. CSI Waste Services will provide each homeowner with a 95 gallon trash container and 65 gallon recycling container at no charge. If you do not contact CSI they will provide you these containers before the first of the year. Should you wish to have a smaller garbage container than the 95 gallon totter you need to **contact CSI at 771-4200** and inform them of your size change. Deadline for this was marked as December 1st on their postcard but the change can be made at anytime. If you missed this deadline it may not happen until after the first of the year. Options for smaller container are a 65 and a 35 gallon size. All sizes are on display at the Recreation Building.

Your current collection day will remain the same, either Monday or Tuesday. CSI will collect the same as we have had in the past. Large items or bulky items that do not fit in the totter can be set to the side and will be collected. As you place your totter(s) at the curb it should be facing out with the wheels towards your house. Even if you have a smaller amount of recycling please use the totter with the yellow lid and face it also out at the curb. CSI utilizes a collection truck that has an extendable arm and grabs your totter and empties it without leaving the truck.

The CSI containers are not a requirement. If you still choose to set a bag or can out it will be picked up the same as it has been in the past. However, you may want to try one of the carts that CSI offers before choosing not to use it.

I want to thank Rumpke for years of service that brought very few calls to my office with complaints. I hope and expect to see them bid on future contracts for the Village service.

If you have a Rumpke totter that you are renting you will need to place that at the curb for your last collection in December. Rumpke will pick them up at that time.

I wish you and your family a happy holiday season and hope to see you at the Lite Up on December 7th.
