Attendance: Mayor Finan, Beth McDaniel, Jeff Albrinck, Chris Patterson, Tom Sextro, Kim Pielage, Cynthia Caracci and Dave Elmer. Barb Rohs called into meeting.

- 1. Finance
  - a. Financial information was passed out to council
  - b. License tax audit will refund \$16,000 back to the VOE
  - c. Successful Bond closing
  - d. Tax Budget will be on the July agenda which determines if the VOE collects a property tax
  - e. Too early to determine the financial impact of current state of the economy. Some federal funds will be allocated through the local government fund but it will not be much
- 2. Recreation
  - a. Seasonal hiring ordinance for swim team and concession stand managers
  - b. Age 7+ swim team and inner squad competition starting June 15
  - c. Ordinance for participation refunds on June agenda
  - d. Pool opening was June 1 and passed inspection by HC and received 2020 license
  - e. Adult swim and another session will be added in June
  - f. The policy for opening the center was distributed
  - g. Programming for residence have been taken to the home with home activities and challenges
  - h. Playground project complete and passed drop test. Just waiting for approval to open from the State of Ohio.
  - i. Knothole, softball, golf and swim team are all playing this summer and operating under COVID guidelines.
  - j. Phi Lamdba Pi is still participating
  - k. Mr. Albrinck thanked Kim and her staff for all the changes and adjustments
- 3. Service/Engineering
  - a. Ordinances- Aerohub Phase 2 plat
  - b. Fencing started on bridge over Glendale Milford
  - c. Bill Mechley is potential retire next year and planning is taking place.
  - d. Shred day in July 18.

- e. Salt is being delivered and front end loader is broken and being repaired
- f. 24-hour rain delivered 5 inches of rain. The flood level of the Mill Creek was 16 feet. Most of the flooding was Medallion and Evendale Drive.
- g. Aviation Way has been paved and bridge work is ongoing.
- h. Railing for bridge have been delivered.
- i. Construction meeting and clearing on Thursday for Phase 2
- 4. GHF
  - a. GHF camp will be reopened and members can schedule visits. About 100 new memberships have been sold. Sales at the interpretive center are taking place. All the pork and beef shares have been sold due to the scare of a meat shortage. Cutting garden subscriptions are being sold and kids camps have started with 10 councilors, social distancing will take place and COVID practices are in place. GHF received the PPP loan and the staff has been retained. August Row by Row to go is being planned. This year it will be "Row by Row.. to GO"
  - b. Chris Patterson stated they have stopped all capital expenditures for the year until they now know the status of financial situation.
- 5. Other Business
  - a. Renewal of Ohio plan through Highland and premium went up 7% and some deductibles increase, increase in coverage.
  - b. The mayor was able to negotiate a contract with Anthem for a 18 month plan at 7.9% increase.
- Mr. Sextro made the motion to adjourn followed by Mr. Albrinck.
