1. Fire

Hamilton County fire department has vaccinated 22 people. At this time, Hamilton County is not paying for the testing of Delta yariance.

2. Police

Chief Korte reported he is well aware of the traffic concerns regarding the detours for the pipeline. The department will be diligent with traffic enforcement and speed devises. The stop sgns and speed on municipal grounds will be enforced. Use of Force policy will be discussed in August meetings.

4. Building, Planning and Zoning

Mr. Rodney reported he will have an ordinance regarding the Reading Rd property to file a lien for grass cutting. Also, ordinances for first reading- amending zone code regulating types of retail uses, amending code requiring pool cover instead of fencing. Both have been placed in the VOE news letter.

The VOE is well aware of the Homers property dumping issues. Mr. Burke is setting up a meeting with business owners to discuss future of property.

Mayor Finan believes the VOE has already been thorough on the process of rejecting the pipeline and does not see the benefit of Mr. Schaefer's proposed ordinance.
