Meeting called to order at 4:00 p.m.

FIRE: Nothing new to report this month.

POLICE: Lt. Joe Asbrock and Officer Kevin Wedig have begun the initial preparatory work to begin trapping coyotes in the designated areas. Lt. Jeff McDaniels is having rotator cuff surgery and will be out approximately 2 to 4 months – pending approval from Councilperson McDaniels !

SERVICE / ENGINEERING: ODOT has delayed the Reading Rd. project until next spring. The installation of the new streetlights on Briton Trail has not yet been scheduled by Duke Energy. Tim Hammonds will be out the rest of this year for knee replacement surgery. Full report is on Google drive.

CODE ENFORCEMENT: A letter has been sent out to a possible new residential rental property.

OTHER BUSINESS: Mrs. Carracci passed out 2018 budget books to the 3 councilmembers. The revision of the personnel code is nearing completion and should be presented to council at the December committee meetings with a first reading hopefully at the December Council meeting. There will be two locations on campus where campaign signs will be permitted on election day. Mr. Elmer informed the committee that it appears the former Homers building is under lease for a possible conference & banquet center / adult nightclub / possible bar.
