Dear Neighbors and Friends:

The Village wants to help protect you from identity theft so we are again having a Shred Day. Mark your calendar for Saturday, April 12th from 9:00 am to 12 noon at the municipal complex. This event is open to Evendale residents and shredding will be performed by an onsite professional shredder.

I want to thank Council for approving a Redevelopment Agreement with BMour, Ltd. at the March Council meeting. This is referred to as the Brendamour building and is on Medallion Drive. The Village worked closely with Doug Brendamour, the Ohio Department of Transportation, and Duke Energy to allow the property owner to utilize unused areas into enough parking spaces to accommodate 250 vehicles. This allowed Mr. Brendamour to secure a long term lease with his tenant, GE Aviation, and retain 500 jobs and add 250 new jobs. This is a great Project maximizing a re-purposed building and demonstrating strong intergovernmental cooperation. I want to again thank Council and everyone who was involved in getting this project done.

Spring is here and along with the warmer weather comes the threat of dangerous storms. The National Weather Service issues the weather watches and warnings that we frequently hear on the local weather forecasts. According to the National Weather Service, a “weather watch” means that the conditions are right for dangerous weather. A “weather warning” is an indication that dangerous weather is threatening the area and you should seek shelter immediately. Hamilton County will sound the sirens at a weather warning or when severe weather is possible. When you hear the sirens you should seek shelter and obtain more information from the TV, radio or internet. A weather radio is one of the best ways to stay tuned-in to dangerous weather. Our Fire Department sells Weather Alert Radios to residents and Village businesses. You can purchase a radio, by stopping by the Fire Department, Monday – Friday between the hours of 9:00 am – 4:00 pm. The cost of the radio is \$20.00.

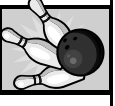
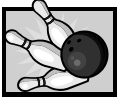
