

Dear Neighbors and Friends,

Over the past several years, the Village has been upgrading our street lights and traffic signals along Reading and Glendale-Milford Roads. It has been a time consuming project, but well worth it. I feel that these main thoroughfares provide visitors their first impression of Evendale and these new street lights, traffic signals and landscaped islands definitely generate a positive image of our Village.

Lately, we have found a number of signs taped to our new street and traffic signal poles. Not only do these signs clutter the intersections, they also cause tape buildup on the poles and often when tape is removed, the paint is removed as well. As a reminder, any type of sign is prohibited in the right-of-way, including signs affixed to poles. If you are going to put out a sign, please remember to place it ten feet behind the right-of-way and if you are not sure contact the Building Department at 956-2665.
