Dear Neighbors and Friends:

Village Council is considering the replacement of street lights in those subdivisions with underground utility wiring. As part of this consideration, there has been a sample installed of the proposed new light. This light is on the Village grounds and is next to the mailbox across from the Administration Building. The Village has strict regulations for door-to-door solicitation. Anyone selling goods or services in Evendale must be registered with the Village. Once a commercial solicitation request is completed, each registered individual will be issued a picture ID card. Please ask to see their ID card before engaging in a conversation with them. If they are unable to produce their Village issued ID card, please report them to our Police Department at 563-2249. Charitable, religious or political solicitors are not required to be registered.

Village Council recently passed an ordinance regulating removal of dead, dying, and hazardous trees. This ordinance enables the Village to order the removal of trees which pose a threat to neighboring property, public right-of-way areas, and streams/creeks/waterways. Council also put money in the budget to remove and trim those trees on public property. If you have a question or need to report a hazardous tree, please contact the Building Dept. at 956-2665.

Please take time to read the insert from the Hamilton County Soil & Water Conservation District. Through their Fall Tree Program you can purchase a 4 – 7 foot tree for only \$5.00.
