Last month the Village used our emergency notification system to let residents know about the change in the day that Republic was going to collect waste containers. The Village uses this system to notify residents and businesses in the event of an emergency or other urgent information. If you did not receive last month's notification or there has been a change in your contact information, please call the Fire Department at 563-2248. They will assist you with signing up for this service or any information updates.

The Evendale Chamber of Commerce is accepting applications for their 2014 Christopher Dyer Memorial Scholarship. High school seniors who live in Evendale are eligible to apply. Four \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to college bound applicants. The Village has been very fortunate over the last several years and especially when realizing the revenue decreases our neighbors and many communities in the country have been facing. In 2013 the Village collected \$13.17 million in earnings tax compared to \$12.75 million in 2012. This was a 3.3% increase. A part of that total was the business portion which in 2013 was \$1.2 million compared to \$1.07 million in 2012. This equates to a 12.3% increase and was the fourth year in a row the Village saw an increase to our business tax revenue. This is great news and speaks to the overall health of companies in Evendale. I also want to thank the many employees who engage our business and make Evendale a great place to live and work. Our employees strive to make Evendale the easiest location to do business and it certainly would appear that these numbers support that claim.
