Dear Neighbors and Friends:

It is my sincere hope that all of our residents had a great holiday season. I am looking forward to 2015. Since this will be my last year as Mayor because of term limits, I wanted to reflect on the past year and the exciting changes that are yet to come.

2014 was an exciting year in the Village. The Council approved several property purchases which will allow us to control the future development of these properties. In addition, our Community Improvement Corporation has been working tirelessly to market and develop our existing land bank properties.

We also saw some commercial growth last year. Med Mart has doubled the size of their store at their current location. They are being recognized as our Business of the Month. Please have a look at their write-up on the back page of this newsletter. Mr. Clean Car Wash has done some improvements making their building more attractive and efficient. O'Reilly's Auto Parts has received approval from Council for a lot split. They will be constructing a new building at 10800 Reading Road. I predict that we will continue to see new commercial developments in the Village in the New Year.

In 2015 we will see the replacement of street lights in the Village with the newest technology. The new shelter house will be completed in the spring. I'm also encouraging Council to rewrite our current Property Maintenance Code. Strengthening this section of the code will only make Evendale more attractive for new residents and businesses.

Republic still provides our curbside waste and recycling collections for our residents. Collections may start as early as 6:00 AM so please set your containers out the night before. If your regularly scheduled pick up day falls on a holiday, Republic will be providing pick up the next day. If you need a new trash can, recycling bin or a special pick up, please call Republic at 771-4200. Special pickups can be requested for carpet, furniture and mattresses. Carpet must be cut into 4' lengths, rolled and tied. Furniture and mattresses must be wrapped in plastic.
