After lunch, FunShines will choose between designated activities including, but not limited to group games, sports, arts & crafts, G & PG movies, reading books, Lego's, outdoor play and more! Activities will be separated by age groups whenever possible. On Mondays and Wednesdays, participants will have the opportunity to go swimming at the pool. Bathing suits, towels and sunscreen must be sent every day; Leaders cannot apply sunscreen. Leaders are assigned to each area throughout the day.
