Dear Neighbors and Friends:

It is my pleasure to announce that Officer Steve Roach received the 2012 Hamilton County Police Association Honor Guard Officer of the Year Award. His commitment to this organization and to his position as a Police Officer is an indication of the quality of police personnel that the Evendale Police Department has on staff.

We are fortunate to have weekly curbside recycling in Evendale, so let's make the most of it. As a reminder, here is a list of the things you can recycle: #1 & #2 plastic containers, glass bottles/jars, aluminum & steel cans, paper, and cardboard. Hamilton County has an excellent website, hamiltoncountyclecyles.org, with suggestions on reducing waste and recycling. Please contact Republic at 771-4200, if you don't have a recycling cart or if you need a replacement.

If you wish to dispose of larger household items they must be placed on the curb on Mondays by 7:00 AM. Discarded refrigerators and AC units must be tagged, verifying that a certified technician has removed the Freon or CFC. Furniture, small appliances, carpet and mattresses will be picked up by Republic on your normal trash pick days. Note that Republic requires that mattresses be in mattress bags as a handling precaution. If you live on a private lane, you must call the Service Department, 563-4338, to request a special pickup.

The Service Department is currently accepting applications for Seasonal Workers. If you are 18 years or older and would like to apply, applications can be found on the Village website or picked up at the Service or Administration Departments.
