



Youth soccer referees needed!

Do you enjoy making money, getting exercise, watching soccer, helping your community? Then get certified as a Cincy Central SAY soccer referee. A class to go through the rule differences for younger age groups and how to be successful during matches will be held March 2nd at the Evendale rec center. There will be a Q&A session at the end.

Class is mandatory for Evendale and Sharonville referees that are high school age or younger

Who can be a SAY soccer referee?

Anyone born before March 1st 2011. Parent child teams are welcomed and encouraged. Get out with your child and make some money with them.

How much will you be paid?

\$20-\$30/match. Pay is dependent on the age group of the match, and you will receive cash at the field before each match. Usually, multiple matches can be done in a single day. Matches range from 40 mins to 1 hour.

When are matches?

Matches are on Saturday mornings with just a few spread out during the week. You get to choose your schedule, if a match doesn't fit your schedule, you can simply turn it down.

Where are matches located?

For Sharonville based communities all matches are in Sharonville. Historically matches have been at Gower Park and Kemper Fields and Sharonville Elementary. For Evendale all matches are played at the rec center.
