I understand that failure to comply with any property maintence or similar regulatory code may subject me, my agent and tenants to legal action(s) including, but not limited to, the issuance of corrective, property condemnation and/or nuisance abatement orders and/or the filing of criminal charges. The Village of Evendale Zoning Code permits single-family dwellings only. Village ordinance
prohibits more than four (4) occupancies per year. Multi-family dwellings are prohibited. The application fee is \$100.00 per property.
