Dear Neighbors and Friends,

It is difficult to appreciate the true burden of regulation until you are involved in the administrative side of government. We seek to minimize red tape in the Village as much as possible, but other parts of the government often tie our hands. The often-mandated approvers of village plans and projects include the Hamilton County Engineer, the Metropolitan Sewer District, Duke Energy for gas and electric, the Cincinnati Water Works - and the list goes on. The Cincinnati Water Works has been an increasing problem. They seem to have three speeds, "slow", "slower" and "slowest". And lately moving things through Duke Energy has been very challenging. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work through the labyrinth of regulations to better serve the residents of Evendale.

Next, I want to alert all Village residents that this an election year for the Council and the Mayor of Evendale. There will be three Council seats contested this year, as well as the Mayor's position. We will have at least one new Councilperson, since Councilman John Ranz is term-limited and cannot run again. A Council term is four years, as is the term for Mayor. We meet every second Tuesday of the month. Each Councilperson is appointed to one of two sub-committees. The committees currently meet the first Tuesday of the month. If you are interested in running for office, please don't hesitate to contact me. It would be a pleasure to help you learn about the responsibilities of being Mayor or a Councilperson.

## ADOPTED ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS

The following ordinances were adopted by Council at their Regular Council Meeting on March 12, 2019. The complete ordinance and support information are available at the Administration Office. If you would like to view this information or if you have any questions, please contact our Village Clerk, Barb Rohs, at 563-2244.

**Ord. #19-12** - Ordinance authorizing the payment of amounts due upon certain contracts requiring certification of availability of funds and declaring an emergency.

**Ord. #19-13** - Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for a Direct Source Capture Vehicle Exhaust System for the Village of Evendale Fire Department and declaring an emergency.

**Ord. #19-14** - Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to execute contracts pursuant to Evendale's Tuition Reimbursement Program for Full Time Village Employees set out in Section 258.075 of the Evendale Code or Ordinance and declaring an emergency.

An emergency clause is frequently added to an ordinance in order to allow the ordinance or resolution to go into effect immediately upon adoption. Under Evendale's Charter the emergency provision must be separately voted on and approved by no less than 5 members of Council. It must include a reason for why it is necessary

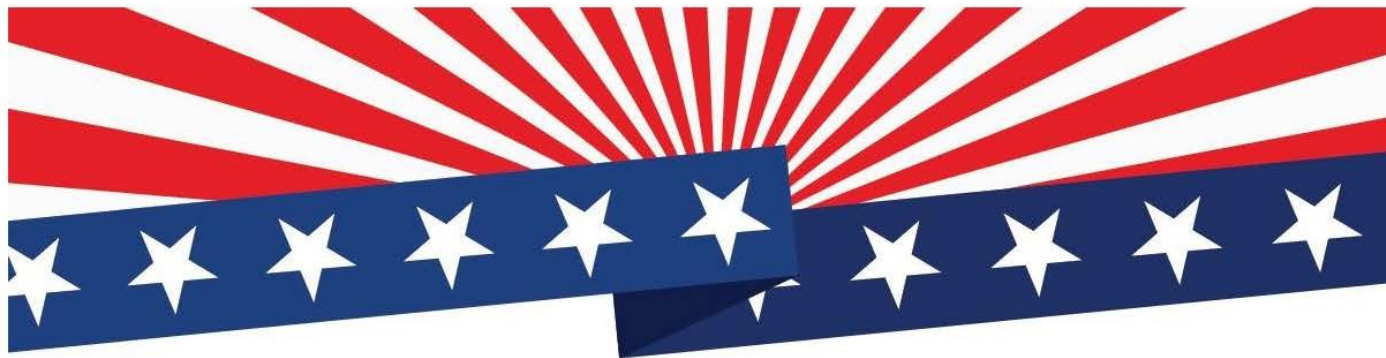

Parent and child are welcome to participate in this class until the child is 3-years-old and comfortable moving to the Flounder class on their own.

**Skills** - Water safety, proper use of flotation devices, water acclimation, movement through water, floating in the water, blowing bubbles, and more.

##### **Requirements** -

A parent (or responsible adult) is re-

quired to participate in the water with each child.

All children must wear a swim diaper. Registration is limited to one class per session per child.

##### **Level 1: Flounder Skills**

**Prerequisites** - Child must be at least 3-years-old and willing to participate in class without a parent.

**Focus** - Water Acclimation, Submersion, Air Exchange.

Child will become acclimated to the water through games and will learn basic safety skills in addition to water submersion and floating with support.

**Skills** - Independent movement through the water, floating on front and back, recovery from a floating position, nose/mouth bubbles, introduction to bobs, and age-appropriate safety skills.

##### **Requirements** -

Any child not potty-trained must wear a swim diaper.

Parent (or responsible adult) must remain on pool deck during lessons. Registration is limited to one class per child per session.

##### **Level 2: Jellyfish Skills**

**Prerequisite** - Successful completion of Flounder skills.

**Focus** - Body Position, Forward Momentum.

Child will expand on the skills learned in the Flounder class and learn to be in the water unassisted in both front and back positions while learning to propel themselves through the water using either arms or legs.

**Skills** - Floating, gliding, streamline body position, recovery, bobs, sub-

mersion, propulsive kicking, introduction to propulsive arms, sit dives, and safety skills.

##### **Requirements** -

Swimmers must wear proper swim attire.

Parent (or responsible adult) must remain on pool deck during lessons. Registration is limited to one class per child per session.

##### **Level 3: Octopus Skills**

**Prerequisite** - Successful completion of Jellyfish skills.

**Focus** - Coordination, Strong Flutter Kick, Introduction to Competitive Kicks.

Child will learn fundamental freestyle and backstroke skills with emphasis placed on the coordination and timing of the strokes as well as the development of a strong flutter kick.

**Skills** - Novice freestyle, novice backstroke, elementary backstroke, side glide, treading, kneel dive, and safety skills.

##### **Requirements** -

Swimmers must wear proper swim attire.

Parent (or responsible adult) must remain on pool deck during lessons. Registration is limited to one class per child per session.

Swim goggles (not a snorkel or mask) may be used by children in levels 3 and above.
