Dear Neighbors and Friends:

Now that the 4th of July has come and gone, we can get back to basics. The Recreation staff, Phi Lambda Pi and all the volunteers delivered a great July 4th celebration.

We started off July with General Electric Aircraft Engines celebrating the Imagination of Flight at their GE Evendale campus. I was invited to the function along with David Elmer, our Director of Administrative Services. It was a walk back into the history of the jet engine and the first jet flight. A that time, they took a plane with a Liberty Piston engine and attached this new thing called a "jet engine". They took off from McCook Field in Dayton, now Wright Patterson Air Base - and it worked! We also met Hoot Gibson, a retired NASA astronaut and professional pilot. He shared many of stories of planes with GE engines that he flew.

Sargent Holloway was the trainer; and I'll tell you from personal experience, it is realistic. The Formica employees said it was an eye-opener. All our police are top notch. I often see our officers patrolling our streets, participating in village events and helping the public. The next time you meet one in person, remember that a word of thanks goes a long way."

SERVICE DEPARTMENT

The Evendale Service Department enacted a new procedure for the Residential Leaf Bag Program in 2017. If you have any questions, please contact the Service Department at 513-563-4338.

- 1. Leaf bags will only be issued on Saturdays from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm and Wednesdays from 1:00 pm to 7:00 pm.
- 2. For 2019, the dates will be:

Saturday, September 14, 21 & 28, October 5, 12, & 19

Wednesday, October 2 & 9

- 3. To ensure bags are available for all homeowners, during the month of September each household will be issued a maximum of 50 bags.
- 4. Any additional bags available, will be issued on the October dates, up to a maximum of 75 total bags per household while supplies last.
- 5. Each household will have to sign for the bags. (Proof of residency may be required)
- 6. You may only pick up the bags for your household.
- 7. There is a limited amount of bags available and are issued on a first come basis.



FIRE DEPARTMENT

CALL 911 if you have any of the following symptoms:

Trouble breathing Sudden trouble speaking

Spinal injury Difficulty speaking or swallowing

Heavy bleeding Shortness in breath
Major broken bone Severe head injury
Major cut or burn Sudden change in vision

Chest pain Severe allergic reaction such as tongue/throat swelling

The fire department will begin testing the fire hydrants located throughout the Village in the coming weeks. This project will last through the rest of the summer and into the fall. You can visit the Evendale Emergency Services Facebook page to see the video of the process.

The equipment we will be using is designed to divert the water flow from the hydrant directly to the street and thus hopefully avoiding any property damage. The goal of this testing is to provide the fire department with the amount of water that can flow from each fire hydrant and water main. This information is vital to us as it helps us know the amount of water we will have available when responding to structure fires.

Testing a fire hydrant's flow can cause the risk of disturbing sediment present within the water mains, which can then sometimes reach a household's water supply. Signs of this sediment will be a rust coloration of running water and can be corrected by running a faucet until it is clear again. This risk is present with any operation of our fire hydrants and the fire department will take the proper preventative measures to reduce this risk.

Fliers will be distributed to mailboxes where testing will occur that day to further explain the process. Please call the Evendale Fire Department with any questions, and if you see this testing on your street feel free to come ask one of us about it!

ADOPTED ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS

The following ordinances were adopted by Council at their Regular Council Meeting on July 2, 2019. The complete ordinance and support information are available at the Administration Office. Ord. #19-40 – Ordinance appropriating funds and appointing Robert ML Green as a Fire Fighter/Paramedic for the Village of Evendale and declaring an emergency.

Unanimously Approved

Ord. #19-42 – Ordinance authorizing the payment of amounts due upon certain contracts requiring Certification of Availability of Funds and declaring an emergency.

Unanimously Approved

Ord. #19-43 – Ordinance approving the hiring and appointing of Andrew E. Rodney as Building, Planning and Zoning Manager of the Village of Evendale and declaring an emergency.

Unanimously Approved

Ord. #19-44 – Ordinance approving the rehiring and appointing of Peter L. Faillace as Police Officer of the Village of Evendale and declaring an emergency.

Unanimously Approved

An emergency clause is frequently added to an ordinance in order to allow the ordinance or resolution to go into effect immediately upon adoption. Under Evendale's Charter the emergency provision must be separately voted on and approved by no less than 5 members of Council. It must include a reason for why it is necessary


