

VILLAGE OF EVENDALE

Dear Neighbors and Friends:

On June 18th we had the official ground breaking ceremony for our first business in the AeroHub development along Glendale-Milford Road, across from St. Rita's School. The Modal Shop (TMS) is building a 40,000 square foot building with an option to add two 30,000 square foot additions. TMS make high tech vibration testing equipment. We foresee this to be the first of many new businesses to come to AeroHub.

On July 25th, Lt. Governor, John Husted, will be in Evendale to tour the AeroHub project. Accompanying him will be retired Air Force Colonel Joseph E. Zeis Jr., the Governor's Aerospace & Defense Consultant and J.P. Nausef, the new President and Chief Investment Officer of JobsOhio, the economic development arm of Ohio. We are seeking funding for the continuation of AeroHub Boulevard north of Glendale-Milford Road.

On another note, the ACLU is on Mayor's Courts for supposedly being big profit making engines for their communities. In Evendale, this is demonstrably false. Most tickets issued by the police department are for speeding and assured clear distance ahead (rear-end) violations. The fine for these citations is \$99.00 for which the Village receives \$60.00 with \$10.00 of that going to the Mayor's Court Computer Fund and \$39.00 going to the state. In 2018, we took in \$146,492.00. Out of that we paid expenses for the clerk, the magistrate (I don't do Mayor's Court), the prosecutor and other occasional services such as an interpreter and a Public Defender. We also have two police officers assigned for each bi-monthly session. The estimated cost for Mayor's Court in 2018 was \$101,558.00 and as you can see, it is not a big profit maker.

Why do we have a Mayor's Court? First of all, convenience. Our sessions are in the evenings while Municipal Courts start at 9:00 a.m. Our police, victims, and witnesses do not have to travel downtown and nor do the defendants. And, parking is free.

I have believed in Mayor's Courts for a long time. They hear misdemeanor and traffic cases that don't require big legal events. If an individual is not satisfied with the Magistrate's decision, they can appeal it to the Municipal Court and that doesn't happen very often. Today, many of our cases are thefts (shoplifting) cases that are not especially difficult to adjudicate. The police officers understand which cases, such as the driving under the influence offenses, should go to Municipal Court.

Finally, just imagine how many new Municipal Judges (and staff) would be necessary to handle the load if communities collectively started sending all the cases downtown. Your tax dollars to fund this endeavor would inevitably rise.

ADOPTED ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS

The following ordinances were adopted by Council at their Regular Council Meeting on June 11, 2019. The complete ordinance and support information are available at the Administration Office. Ord. #19-32 – Ordinance approving the 2020 Tax Budget of the Village of Evendale and declaring an emergency.

Unanimously Approved

Ord. #19-33 – Ordinance authorizing the payment of amounts due upon certain contracts requiring certification of availability of funds and declaring an emergency. Unanimously Approved

Ord. #19-34 – Ordinance approving a transfer from the Contingency Fund to the Administrative Fund and declaring an emergency.

Ord. #19-35 – Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Medical Mutual of Ohio to provide a comprehensive health insurance benefit to full time village employees and declaring an emergency. Unanimously Approved

Ord. #19-36 – Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Ohio Plans Risk Management, Inc. to provide Property and Liability Insurance with the assistance of Hylant Administrative Services for the Village of Evendale and declaring an emergency. Unanimously Approved

Ord. #19-37 – Ordinance amending subsection 258.095(b) of the Evendale Code of Ordinances and declaring an emergency. Unanimously Approved

Ord. #19-38 – Ordinance authorizing Mayor to setting pay rates for the Service Department and declaring an emergency. Unanimously Approved

Ord. #19-39 – Ordinance establishing a special revenue fund to be known as the Griffin Family Nature Preserve and declaring an emergency. Unanimously Approved

An emergency clause is frequently added to an ordinance in order to allow the ordinance or resolution to go into effect immediately upon adoption. Under Evendale's Charter the emergency provision must be separately voted on and approved by no less than 5 members of Council. It must include a reason for why it is necessary


