SERVICE DEPARTMENT

The Evendale Service Department enacted a new procedure for the Residential Leaf Bag Program in 2017. If you have any questions, please contact the Service Department at 513-563-4338.

Leaf bags will only be issued on Saturdays from 9:00 am to 1:00 on September 15, 22 & 29. To ensure bags are available for all homeowners, each household will receive a maximum of 50 bags.

Any surplus bags will be distributed on Saturdays, October 6^{th} , 13^{th} , and 20^{th} from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm and Wednesdays, October 3^{rd} and 10^{th} from 1:00 pm to 7:00 pm. While supplies last, residents may pick up an additional 25 bags per household.

Each household will have to sign for the bags. (Proof of residency may be required)

You may only pick up the bags for your household.

There is a limited amount of bags available and are issued on a first come basis.

ADOPTED ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS

The following ordinances were adopted by Council at their Regular Council Meeting on August 14, 2018. The complete ordinance and support information are available at the Administration Office. Ord. #18-50 – Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to execute a Deed of Easement to Evendale Industrial, LLC for the purposes of a storm water easement and declaring an emergency.

Approved

Ord. #18-51 – Ordinance authorizing Mayor to purchase from the Hamilton County, Ohio Procurement Program unleaded gasoline and road grade diesel fuel and declaring an emergency.

Approved

Ord. #18-52 – Ordinance authorizing the Police Chief to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy to transfer a 2013 Ford Police Interceptor Vehicle and declaring an emergency.

Approved

Ord. #18-53 – Ordinance authorizing the payment of amounts due upon certain contracts requiring certification of availability of funds and declaring an emergency.

Approved

Res. #18-01 – Resolution recommending public safety as a criteria used by the Ohio Power Sitting Board when considering applications for natural gas pipelines.

Approved

Res. #18-02 - Resolutions consenting to the execution of an agreement between the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio and the Modal Shop Inc. providing for the adoption of a project which will expand a business in the Village of Evendale and create and/or preserve employment opportunities within an enterprise zone of Hamilton County declaring an emergency.

Approved

An emergency clause is frequently added to an ordinance in order to allow the ordinance or resolution to go into effect immediately upon adoption. Under Evendale's Charter the emergency provision must be separately voted on and approved by no less than five members of Council. It must include a reason for why it is necessary


