1. Finance
 - a. Approximately \$200,000 less than YTD from 2019 but still hopeful in making budget
 - b. CARES money was received for \$73,000 and working with Chief Hauck
 - c. Law Enforcement Trust Fund Ordinance
 - d. Ordinances have been distributed via email
2. Recreation
 - a. Pool goes to reduced hours on August 17
 - b. Ordinance for extending Swim Safe ordinance
 - c. Fitness center will go out for bid and an RFP will go out
 - d. Halloween Fest planning
3. Service/Engineering
 - a. Shred day on July 18 was a success and collection was up 70%
 - b. Transition for Bill Mechley retirement is in the process which will be beginning for 2021
 - c. Ordinances- Ordering of equipment from state bid list and TIF fund and Ms. Caracci is comfortable with purchases
 - d. Interstate project is moving slow
 - e. Tower project is based on Thru the Valley
 - f. Aerohub phase 2- retaining wall is being installed
 - g. Ordinance- Silco water management
4. GHF
 - a. GHF is open and masks are required
 - b. Row by Row is almost sold out
 - c. SBA PPP was received for payroll for Covid
 - d. Sunflower festival is being planned but in a different capacity
 - e. Summer Kids Camps end 8/5/20. Camps went amazingly well. Total participants = 292
 - f. Bank barn work is complete

- g. Sewer line work will begin soon
 - h. Shorty was put to rest on July 28. He was 23 years old and had been an integral part of our education programs at GHF since 2005
5. Other business
- a. Ordinance- 2 Aero hub- Plans and Covenant
 - b. FYI- Electric aggregation program will expire at end of 2020 and bids are being collected by Energy Alliance
 - c. Possible ordinances coming in the future- rezoning of firing range
 - d. MOU with the City of Cincinnati and Neyer for police firing range is in the works
 - e. Silco project continues to move forward
 - f. Additional time is needed for Kinetic project
 - g. Mr. Albrinck will not be at the council meeting in September
