# 10500 Reading Road Fire, Police, Service, Engineering and GHF January 8, 2019 4:00 pm, Council Chambers

## 1. Fire

- a. Medical Marijuana ordinance draft has been distributed to council and department heads. This ordinance will be in front of council soon after revisions. VOE is a zero tolerance employer.
- b. Ambulance update- the ambulance will be in the VOE at the end of the week and then there will be training and the cot system needs to be installed. The ambulance will be non-transport until power cot is installed.
- c. Construction area accidents are up 33% for 2018.

#### 2. Police

- a. Department report- The will be an ordinance for the mutual aid for SWAT and Mobile Field Force at the January meeting.
- b. Officer Woods passed away 1-7-19. Colerain will need mutual aid during funeral and the Chief will send over support.

## 3. Service/Engineering

- a. Trash can update- ½ the cans have been collected and will be complete soon. The City of Cleves and others are collecting the cans to re-use.
- b. Public hearings for Duke Pipeline and Mill Creek -Duke has asked to reopen the process to the Ohio Siting Board on March 21 from 3-8 at UC Blue Ash. This is for public input not public officials input. The adjudication hearing will be on April 9<sup>th</sup> in Columbus.
- c. Interstate project is in the winter shut down. On Jan 28 for 460 days the Sherman Ave. Bridge will be closed and traffic will be rerouted.
- d. Preliminary estimates for the railings will be forwarded when received.
- e. \$10,000 grant has been awarded from the Greater Cincinnati Foundation.
- f. The roundup on Plainfield Rd. is complete.
- g. Mill Creek Conservatory District public hearing is January 16, 2018.
- h. Vacation of St. Rita's Lane and Plat will be ordinances on the agenda for January.
- i. There will be also be the  $2^{nd}/3^{rd}$  reading of the declaration of covenants and easements for Aerohub South.
- j. All the equipment has been ordered for the FD HVAC equipment for north end of the building.

#### 4. GHF

- a. Sadly the GHF Livestock Manager Alyssa Atkinson passed on 12/23/18. A Celebration of Life Service was held at GHF. She was a much loved member of our "Farm Family" and will forever be missed. The family requested donations to the Farm in lieu of flowers or cards.
