1. Fire-
 - a. 5 final candidates will meet with the hiring committee on October 24th for the firefighter/EMT position. Mr. Ranz, Bill Puthoff and Caroline Smiley-Robertson are on hiring committee.
 - b. Ambulance update- The department is not eligible to apply for the \$40,000 grant from BWC for a power cot and loading system. Chief is working on a solution.
 - c. There will be a resolution adopting Hamilton County multiple hazard mitigation plan for police and fire.
 - d. Accidents with injuries are up 53% and overall incidents are up 17% mainly due to I-75 traffic patterns
 - e. Sports Plus has had 7 false alarms in the past 2 months and 13 to date in 2018. The Chief is working with ownership to resolve this issue.
2. Police
 - a. No updates
3. Service/Engineering: Mr. Jeffers was not in attendance
 - a. Service department report is attached.
 - b. Reading Rd resurfacing is complete.
 - c. The VOE has received an award for the best recycling village.
 - d. The Mill Creek Conservancy District is holding a public hearing on October 18th, 4-6, to possibly initiate a stream tax for the Millcreek.
4. GHF
 - a. Farm office renovation will be finished mid-month.
 - b. The farm house will be connected to sewer.
 - c. Sunflower festival is Oct 6/7.
 - d. Bank barn renovation is being bid.
 - e. Fall field trips are full.
 - f. A firm will be hired to analyze capital campaign.
 - g. Mr. Ranz asked Mr. Patterson to check into the signage at the Boy Scout building. He believes that part of their agreement is they are supposed to advertise Farm functions.
5. Finance
 - a. Ms. Caracci handed out the 2019 budget. It is a starting point. Capital items will be ranked but waiting for October numbers.

6. Other Business
