Dear Neighbors and Friends:

As we approach Senior Prom and Graduation season, Police Chief Korte would like to remind residents of the Ohio law commonly known as the "Keg Law". This law holds parents responsible if they knowingly allow underage drinking at their home. Please keep this in mind when you are hosting parties with underage persons and make sure everyone stays safe while having fun.

The Village of Evendale will be sponsoring a Shred Day on Saturday, May 18th, 10:00 am -2:00 pm. A mobile document shredding vehicle will be in the parking lot in front of the Municipal Building and next to the tennis courts. Document shredding provides secure, confidential disposal of sensitive information. It also fights identity theft by destroying personal items like receipts, financial statements, tax returns, and medical and insurance records. The Village will have staff present on Shred Day to quickly allow you to drop off items. To show support for a green side of Shred Day, the Village will be handing out seedlings to the first 100 persons who have documents shredded. You must be a Village resident to participate in Shred Day.

On March 14th, Cincinnati State Development Center on Reading Road in Evendale hosted the first Certification Ceremony for the national program of Get Skills to Work, Military to Manufacturing. This program is designed to help veterans translate their military experience into advanced manufacturing opportunities. There were eleven recipients honored. Dr. O'Dell M. Owens, President of Cincinnati State, David Joyce, President and CEO of GE Aviation, and Gary Sinise, actor and veteran's advocate, all of whom are major supporters of this program, were in attendance to honor this first class of graduates.
