Dear Neighbors and Friends:

Our Village Charter requires Council to appoint a Charter Review Committee every five years. This committee will have the opportunity to review the entire Charter and make suggestions on changes. Their recommendations will be brought before Council and, if there is a consensus, the changes will be put on an upcoming ballot. Two residents, two business representatives and one Council member are needed to serve on this committee. In the past, the time commitment was less than six months, with monthly meetings. If you are interested in serving on this committee, please call the Administration Office, 563-2244, to submit your name. We hope to have the appointments to this committee completed by May 1st.

Spring is here and we have a lot happening around the Village. You will see several extra inserts included in this newsletter. One is for our annual Shred Day, which is coming up on May 2nd. This has turned into a big event as we have shredded nearly 6 tons of personal data for our residents. All the details may be found on the insert.

This annual award is given to communities whose efforts have contributed to the elevation of planning principles and improved quality of life. Thank you to Michele Gottschlich, our Recreation Commission and all who have dedicated many hours on building a bike and pedestrian trail in Evendale.
