Dear Neighbors and Friends:

The Recreation Department has been busy preparing for another fun-filled 4<sup>th</sup> of July celebration. Please remember that the 10 K run starts at 8:00 AM. The following roads will be closed or have limited traffic access to them until approximately 10:00 AM: Acton Court, Ambler Drive, Cooper Road, Cooperhill Drive, Lamarck Trail, Otterbein Road, Oxbow Trail, Stanwin Place, and Winnebago Trail. There are planned activities at the pool and Recreation Center starting at 2:00 PM. The day will end with Rozzi's Famous Fireworks at 10:00 PM.

Drainage and resurfacing work on Wyscarver Road, north of Margate Terrace, will start at the end of June and continue through October. Although one lane of traffic should remain open at all times, there may be times where temporary closures of the road will be necessary. Access for residents living on Wyscarver will be maintained. To reduce congestion from through-traffic, we are encouraging all drivers to find alternate routes during this project.

The Village of Evendale, as well as our neighboring communities continues to be plagued by thefts from vehicles during the overnight hours. Chief Korte has informed me that the thieves target unlocked vehicles. Please make sure your vehicles are locked overnight.

Congratulations to Ken Puthoff who has been selected as the Ohio Coach of the Year for the Ohio Parks & Recreation Association. He is being honored at the September 5<sup>th</sup> Reds/NY Mets game and will be throwing out the ceremonial first pitch. If you would like to join Ken and his family at the game, you can purchase tickets at the Recreation Center until July 18<sup>th</sup>. The ticket price is \$14.00. The Village is providing bus transportation to and from the game.

It will be in the Recreation Center's North Gym. 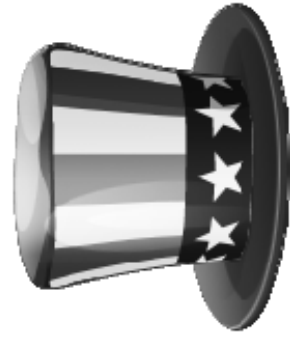

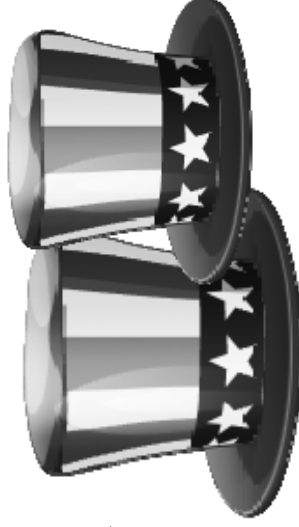
