Good Morning Evendale! The Village of Evendale is starting a daily telephone calling program for seniors, or any Evendale resident. For every resident that signs up for the program, each morning at 9:00 a.m. a call will be placed to the resident just to confirm that all is well. In the event that no one is reached, or help is requested, the Village will send Police or Fire personnel to make sure everything is o.k.

If you would like to receive a call each morning, or if you know someone who might appreciate a call, please let us know. The program is voluntary and there is no cost. The person receiving the call must sign themselves up to receive calls from "Good Morning Evendale".

I would like to thank our Fire Fighter Steve Hamm, Police Lt. Jeff McDaniel, and Adult Services Manager Patty Grist for identifying this need in our community and organizing the program. We are also looking for volunteers to assist with the morning calls and "Good Morning Evendale" is great way to get involved in the community and maybe help a neighbor or friend.
