I hope you're enjoying the Spring weather and all the outdoor activities that come along this time of year. Just a reminder as we catch up with the spring cleaning in our yards, the Service Department provides chipping services to residents on Monday mornings. Please place limbs at the curb with the cut end out and leave the length of the limbs as long as possible. This will make it easier for our Service Department to load them into the chipper. Tree trimming performed by a contractor or professional service will not be chipped by our Service Department. Also, the grass is growing quickly right now, so please be courteous to your neighbors and keep your grass trimmed.

Work has begun to improve all of the traffic signals in the Village in order to help manage traffic flow and to improve visibility. The lights at all traffic signals will be replaced with LED lights. In addition, each intersection will have a black metal mast arm which holds the lights, and each signal head will have a black background plate with a reflective yellow outline. Our street names hanging from each mast arm will also be illuminated. The electronic controls will be updated with state of the art video detectors to help maximize traffic flow.

While we do not experience frequent accidents at intersections, they do happen. Recently a vehicle was struck crossing Glendale-Milford Road at Kingsport Drive. The driver at fault went through the red light on Glendale-Milford Road and was cited for failing to stop at the light. Hopefully the traffic signal improvements will help motorists with visibility and help to keep these types of accidents from occurring.

We have more pedestrians, cyclers, and motorists out and about now that warmer weather has arrived. Please continue to use caution when driving into the Village complex and throughout the Village at our busy intersections.

Fun in the Sun Summer Program

SunBeams, Ages 3 – 6 M-TH, 9:30 - 11:00 AM

Must be potty trained <u>and</u> three years of age by 6/4/12; Children cannot enroll in the program if they turn three during the six week session.

SunBeams is a highly structured morning program. Children are split into three age groups and rotate between three daily stations, including, but not limited to, gym games, crafts, playground, song and dance, etc. Leaders are assigned to each area and each age group. FunShines begin their day with a group meeting followed by a pre-lunch activity. Lunch is eaten between 12:00-12:30; vending machine and concession purchases strongly discouraged. *Please pack healthy lunches*. Money can be sent for snacks on pool days, Mondays and Wednesdays. After lunch, FunShines will choose between designated activities including, but not limited to group games, sports, arts & crafts, G & PG movies, reading books, Lego's, outdoor play and more! Activities will be separated by age groups whenever possible. On Mondays and Wednesdays, participants will have the opportunity to go swimming at the pool. Bathing suits, towels and sunscreen must be sent every day; Leaders cannot apply sunscreen. Leaders are assigned to each area throughout the day.
