Option 1: Build a car out of your pumpkin

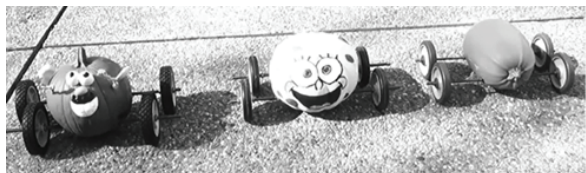
Pumpkin cars will be raced to see which can travel the farther distance! Second or third heats may be necessary. If pumpkin crumples...sorry your out!
