WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council have final review and approval authority for the amendment or removal of existing positions and the creation of new positions. Additionally, Council has traditionally interviewed final candidates for fulltime positions and has final authority to approve, by Ordinance, the hiring of all employees; and, WHEREAS, The revisions to Chapter 258 as proposed in Exhibit "A" attached help to clarify existing, or otherwise establish new, employment practices; now, therefore, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE, STATE OF **OHIO**, six members concurring, that: **SECTION 1**: Evendale Personnel Code Chapter 258 is hereby amended to read as illustrated in Exhibit "A". AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE PLANNING AND ZONING CODE, SECTION 1256.19 AMENDING THE TEXT TO THE INNOVATION DISTRICT PUD REGULATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village owns approximately 53 acres west of Interstate 75, straddling Glendale Milford Road – known as the "AeroHub Site"; and

WHEREAS, the Village has an adopted "AeroHub Innovation District Master Plan" for the AeroHub Site; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 1256 currently includes an "Innovation District PUD" which is contemplated for application at the AeroHub Site; and

whereas, the Planning Commission conducted, with proper public notice, a public hearing on August 20, 2019 regarding proposed changes to the Evendale Zoning Code "Innovation Planned Unit Development District" regulations whereby a provision regarding height minimums on office buildings in AeroHub North would be added to Evendale Zoning Code ("EZC") as sec. 1256.19(f)(2)(A); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission recommended approval of the amendment on September 5, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Evendale has conducted a public hearing on this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Evendale finds it appropriate to amend the Zoning Code of the Village of Evendale to accommodate the height minimums for office uses in the Innovation District Planned Unit Development, to effectuate planning goals for the AeroHub North Site; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE, STATE OF OHIO, six members concurring, that:

Part Twelve, Title Two, Section 1256.19(f)(2)(a) of the Code of the Village of Evendale, is hereby amended to read as follows, with the remainder of Section 1256.19 to remain as written:

a. Within AeroHub North only, stand-alone Professional Offices must be a minimum two functional stories in height. For advanced manufacturing, R&D and other permitted uses that include professional offices in their facility, and which are located in AeroHub North, the office use cannot exceed 25% of the first floor.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure by a concurrence of five members of Council, it being necessary to preserve the public peace, order, safety, health or welfare of the Village of Evendale, or to provide for the daily operation of a department or office of the Village of Evendale. The reason for said emergency is to enact zoning regulations to effectuate the planning goals of the Village and the AeroHub Innovation District Master Plan as soon as possible. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately.

ORDINANCE APPROVING A REZONING OF 38 +/ACRES OF VILLAGE-OWNED LAND FROM INDUSTRIAL FLEX/PUBLIC FACILITIES/MIXED USE PUD TO INNOVATION DISTRICT PUD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village owns approximately 53 acres west of Interstate 75, straddling Glendale Milford Road – known as the "AeroHub Site"; and

WHEREAS, the Village has an adopted "AeroHub Innovation District Master Plan" for the AeroHub Site; and

WHEREAS, approximately 38 acres of the AeroHub Site located north of Glendale Milford Road is known as, "AeroHub North"; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds that the most effective way to carry out its desires for the AeroHub Site is by way of an Innovation District Planned Unit Development pursuant to Evendale Zoning Code Chapter 1256; and

whereas, the Planning Commission conducted, with notice, a public hearing on August 20, 2019 regarding a zone change on [no address] Glendale Milford Road/Oak Road (Parcel ID No. 611-0040-0074), 1400 Glendale Milford Road (Parcel ID No. 611-0040-0007), and 1500 Glendale Milford Road (Parcel ID No. 611-0040-0006) – (collectively, "Subject Property" or "AeroHub North") which are considered part of Phase one of the AeroHub North Site development, from Industrial Flex/Public Facilities/Mixed Use PUD to Innovation District PUD; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission recommended approval of said zone change to Innovation District PUD; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Evendale has conducted a public hearing on this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Evendale finds it appropriate to amend the Zoning Map of the Village of Evendale to accommodate the Innovation District Planned Unit Development on the Subject Property; now, therefore,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE, STATE OF OHIO, five members concurring, that:

SECTION 1: The Subject Property identified as [no address] Glendale Milford Road/Oak Road (Parcel ID No. 611-0040-0074), 1400 Glendale Milford Road (Parcel ID No. 611-0040-0007), and 1500 Glendale Milford Road (Parcel ID No. 611-0040-0006), is hereby rezoned from Industrial Flex/Public Facilities/Mixed Use PUD to Innovation District PUD; and

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure by concurrence of five members of the Village Council. The reason for said emergency is to preserve the public peace, order, safety, health or welfare of the Village of Evendale, or to provide for the daily operations of a department or office of the Village of Evendale. The reason for said emergency is to rezone land in the AeroHub Site to accommodate redevelopment, and to allow potential developers and applicants to submit preliminary concept plans under the Innovation District PUD within the AeroHub North Site for review by the Planning Commission and Council as soon as possible. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately.

WHEREAS, the Village of Evendale has received bids for Glendale Milford Road and Interstate 75 Bridge Towers Project after advertising in a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Evendale; and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends Pepper Construction Company of Ohio, LLC as the lowest and best bid;

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE, STATE OF OHIO, five members concurring that:

SECTION 1: The bid of Pepper Construction Company of Ohio in the amount of \$2,548,768.00 is hereby accepted. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Pepper Construction Company of Ohio for this project.

SECTION 2: The Alternate Bid for Landscaping and Irrigation is hereby rejected.

SECTION 3: The following sum is appropriated to the transfer out account and then transferred from the General Fund Transfer Account:

ORDINANCE APPROVING WATER MANAGEMENT AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL PLANS FOR ENABLE INJECTIONS AND AUTHORIZING BUILDING COMMISSIONER TO ISSUE PERMIT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Bayer Becker, on behalf of SSP Sharon Road, LLC doing business as Enable Injections has submitted a certain set of grading plans on property it owns and/or has an agreement with the adjoining property owner, specifically located at 2863 Sharon Road and more specifically as, Hamilton County Auditor's Book 611, Page 30, Parcel 251 and 160 for an development of a new building and, in accordance with Evendale Ordinance 1466 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer of the Village has given his approval of said plans for the property to be developed by the property owner; and,

WHEREAS, the plans approved by the Village Engineer appear to be in good order and in compliance with the purposes and intent of Evendale Ordinance 1466 et. seq.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE, STATE OF OHIO, six members concurring that:

SECTION 1: The copy of the plans submitted by Bayer Becker on behalf of SSP Sharon Road, LLC, in accordance with Evendale Code Section 1466 and approved by the Village Engineer are hereby attached as Appendix A and made part hereof.

SECTION 2: The Council of the Village of Evendale finds that notwithstanding the requirement in Section 1466.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Evendale, that such plans be held for 30 days before action by Council public policy justification exists to proceed immediately in order to obtain the benefits of the improvements, the reduction of impervious surfaces and the enhancement of greenspace, landscaping and aesthetic appeal of the site as soon as possible and Council further finds said plans as approved by the Engineer to be well taken and to comply with the intent and purposes of Ordinance 1466 et. seq., and are hereby approved by this Council.

SECTION 3: The approval of Council of these plans shall be conditioned upon and shall not take effect until the filing of the plans with the Building Commissioner and filing of the performance bond set by Council in the amount of \$27,000.00. In addition, the issuance of the Water Management and Sedimentation Control Permit is conditioned upon Approval by the Building Department of the proposed plans.

SECTION 4: Copies of the plans as approved by Council shall also be filed with the Clerk, the Engineer, the Building Commissioner, the Planning Commission and the County Soil and Water Conservation District.

SECTION 5: Upon the filing of said approved plans with the Building Commissioner and upon the posting of the bond specified above, the Building Commissioner shall issue the appropriate permit to commence the work, etc. as provided by the approved plans.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall not constitute approval for any building or structure.

SECTION 7: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency by a concurrence of six members of Council, being necessary to preserve the public, peace, order, safety, health or welfare of the Village of Evendale or to provide for the daily operation of a department or office of the Village of Evendale. It is necessary that this measure be put into immediate effect because the public safety and welfare require the work commence immediately to promote the renovation of the site and therefore the economic health of the Village of Evendale and reduce the impervious surface area and enhance landscaping of the site at the earliest possible date. This ordinance shall be effective upon passage.

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE NEW STREET, ADJACENT TO THE GE CAMPUS, AVIATION WAY AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO IMPLEMENT THAT NAME.

- **WHEREAS,** the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) is nearing completion of a new 1.5 mile public roadway connecting Glendale-Milford Rd. and Shepherd Ln. immediately abutting the GE Aviation World Headquarters (see Exhibit "A" map) and;
- **WHEREAS**, upon completion of the roadway, ODOT intends on conveying the public road to Evendale for ownership, maintenance and upkeep in perpetuity; and
- WHEREAS, GE Aviation's current address is 1 Neumann Way. Neumann Way is a small, public roadway providing access to the main portion of GE's campus and on which GE's campus signage is located. Neumann Way will remain in place upon completion of the new roadway and GE Aviation will retain their current address; and,
- WHEREAS, GE Aviation agrees to pay for the design, fabrication, construction or retrofitting and installation of any and all public signage, including highway signs, denoting Aviation Way, should such signs be required or permitted by ODOT, the Village of Evendale, or as may be requested by GE Aviation; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE, STATE OF OHIO, six members concurring, that:

- **SECTION 1:** The new street adjacent to the GE campus shall be named Aviation Way. The Mayor, with the assistance of the Service Director, shall implement that name at such time when, in coordination with GE and the ODOT, it is appropriate to do so.
- **SECTION 2:** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from the earliest date allowed by law.

WHEREAS, due to current and anticipated vacancies, Sergeant positions in the Evendale

Police Department need to be filled; and

VILLAGE OF EVENDALE, OHIO RESOLUTION #19-06

A RESOLUTION CONSENTING TO THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO AND KINETIC VISION, INC. PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF A PROJECT WHICH WILL EXPAND A BUSINESS IN THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE AND CREATE AND/OR PRESERVE EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES WITHIN AN ENTERPRISE ZONE OF HAMILTON COUNTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS.

The Council of the Village of Evendale has, on April 10, 1997, by Ordinance No. 97-33, consented to the establishment of an Enterprise Zone, known as the Reading/Lockland/Evendale/Arlington Heights Enterprise Zone, by the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio, as authorized by Section 5709 of the Ohio Revised Code, which has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS,

On April 16, 1997, the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio did duly establish such a zone; and

WHEREAS.

On July 2, 1997, the Director of Development of the State of Ohio certified the area designated by this Council and the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio as an Urban Jobs and Enterprise Zone pursuant to Section 5709.63(A) of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS,

Kinetic Vision, Inc. (Kinetic), along with Dynamic Sight Properties Ltd, (Dynamic) which will own the property, now proposes a project which will create investment and employment opportunities in the Village of Evendale; and

WHEREAS.

Kinetic has proposed a project which will involve constructing a new 5,000 sq. ft. facility with a total new investment of approximately ten million, one hundred thousand dollars (\$10,100,000.00) retaining one hundred, forty-one employees (141) and adding fifty (50) new full time permanent jobs over three years; and

WHEREAS.

The Council of the Village of Evendale, upon receiving endorsement by the Evendale Community Improvement Corporation, has reviewed the proposed project and is of the opinion that Kinetic is qualified to create and/or preserve employment opportunities in the enterprise zone;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Evendale, Hamilton County, Ohio, six members concurring, that:

SECTION I

The Council hereby gives its consent for the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio, to enter into an enterprise zone agreement with Kinetic, the Enterprise Zone Application of which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

SECTION II This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency by concurrence of five members of Council, being necessary to preserve the public peace, order, safety, health or welfare of the Village of Evendale or to provide for the daily operation of a department or office of the Village of Evendale. It is necessary that this measure be put into immediate effect so the Board of County Commissioners may promptly proceed to enter into the Agreement with Kinetic and the benefits of such agreement be obtained as promptly as possible. This resolution shall be effective upon passage.
