- WHEREAS,** the Council of the Village of Evendale has enacted Chapter 258 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Evendale, requiring authorization by Council for the Mayor to hire new personnel; and
- WHEREAS,** the Mayor has recommended, and the Council has agreed, to hire Kim Pielage as Recreation Department; and
- WHEREAS,** the Mayor and the Administration have fully complied with the relevant and applicable sections of Chapter 258 the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Evendale; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE, STATE OF OHIO, -  
- members concurring, that:

**SECTION 1:** Kim Pielage may be employed, effective April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2017, by the Mayor of the Village of Evendale, as permanent, exempt, employee in the following role at a salary of \$90,000 per year.

**SECTION 2:** This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure by a concurrence of six members of Council, it being necessary to preserve the public peace, order, safety, health or welfare of the Village of Evendale, or to provide for the daily operation of a department or office of the Village of Evendale. It is necessary that this measure be put into immediate effect to make sure that the Village of Evendale Recreation Department is appropriately staffed and Kim Pielage is in place to take over for the retiring Department Director Dave Nichols. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage.

NECESSARY FOR THE PURCHASE AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY**

- WHEREAS,** Over the past several years, the Village of Evendale ,working through the Mayor and the Village Community Improvement Corporation, have acquired several acres of land along Glendale-Milford Rd., west of I-75, for the purpose of nuisance abatement while preparing the land for re-use as an advanced manufacturing campus called AeroHub and;
- WHEREAS,** The Felitto property, located at 1400 Glendale-Milford Rd., immediately abuts Village-owned acreage along its northern and eastern borders making it an ideal inclusion in the AeroHub project and;
- WHEREAS,** Council of the Village of Evendale are satisfied with the terms and conditions of the draft agreement as it conforms to the desires of the Village and the Mayor should be authorized to execute a purchase agreement substantially in conformance with the document attached to this ordinance; and
- WHEREAS,** Pursuant to legislation properly adopted by the council of the Village of Evendale, certain expenditures will take place that need to be appropriately reflected as appropriations upon finalizing of the agreement; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE, STATE OF OHIO, five members concurring, that:

**SECTION 1:** The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement substantially in the form of the **agreement attached** hereto and incorporated by reference herein, which agreement is hereby approved. The Mayor is authorized to approve exhibits to the agreement which shall conform to the terms set forth in the agreement.

**SECTION 2:** The following sum is to be appropriated in the General Fund and transferred from the General Fund to the Capital Fund and appropriated for real estate acquisition:

**SECTION 3:** This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure by a concurrence of five members of Council, it being necessary to preserve the public peace, order, safety, health or welfare of the Village of Evendale, or to provide for the daily operation of a department or office of the Village of Evendale. The reason for said emergency is for Evendale to have the ability to move ahead as soon as possible with the due diligence necessary to proceed with the property acquisition and to have the funds available for the purchase. Therefore, this ordinance shall become effective immediately.

**WHEREAS,** Ohio Revised Code 5705.41(D)(1) provides that where contracts have not been previously certified for sufficient funds being available, Village Council may authorize the drawing of warrants to pay such contracts upon receipt of a certificate from the fiscal officer stating that there was at the time of the making of such contract or order and at the time of the execution of such certificate, a sufficient sum appropriated for the purpose of such contract and in the treasury or in the process of collection to the credit of an appropriate fund free from any previous encumbrances, and

**WHEREAS,** Certain contracts enumerated below are now due and payable for which such a certificate has been provided by the Chief Fiscal and Accounting Officer;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE, STATE OF OHIO, five members concurring, that:**

PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF A PROJECT WHICH  
WILL EXPAND A BUSINESS IN THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE  
AND CREATE AND/OR PRESERVE EMPLOYMENT  
OPPORTUNITIES WITHIN AN ENTERPRISE ZONE OF  
HAMILTON COUNTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS,** The Council of the Village of Evendale has, on April 10, 1997, by Ordinance No. 97-33, consented to the establishment of an Enterprise Zone, known as the Reading/Lockland/Evendale/Arlington Heights Enterprise Zone, by the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio, as authorized by Section 5709 of the Ohio Revised Code, which has been amended from time to time; and

**WHEREAS,** On April 16, 1997, the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio did duly establish such a zone; and

**WHEREAS,** On July 2, 1997, the Director of Development of the State of Ohio certified the area designated by this Council and the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio as an Urban Jobs and Enterprise Zone pursuant to Section 5709.63(A) of the Ohio Revised Code; and

**WHEREAS,** WATSON'S now proposes a project which will create investment and employment opportunities in the Village of Evendale; and

**WHEREAS,** WATSON'S has proposed a project which will involve an investment of approximately One Million Nine Hundred and Thirty Three Thousand and Seven Hundred Dollars (\$1,933,700.00); and the creation of thirty-three (33) new jobs over three years; and

**WHEREAS,** The Council of the Village of Evendale, upon receiving endorsement by the Evendale Community Improvement Corporation, has reviewed the proposed project and is of the opinion that WATSON'S is qualified to create and/or preserve employment opportunities in the enterprise zone;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village Council of the Village of Evendale, Hamilton County, Ohio, five members concurring, that:

**SECTION I** The Council hereby gives its consent for the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio, to enter into an enterprise zone agreement with WATSON'S, a draft of which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

**SECTION II**

This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency by concurrence of -- members of Council, being necessary to preserve the public peace, order, safety, health or welfare of the Village of Evendale or to provide for the daily operation of a department or office of the Village of Evendale. It is necessary that this measure be put into immediate effect so the Board of County Commissioners may promptly proceed to enter into the Agreement with WATSON'S and the benefits of such agreement be obtained as promptly as possible.
