**SECTION 3:** Effective from January 1, 2022, until December 31, 2022, the following are appointed as designated specialist in the Service Department:

- A. Safety Specialist Shannon Lynch
- B. Pesticide Specialist Steve Knebel

<u>SECTION 4</u>: Each specialist appointed by this Resolution shall receive additional compensation in addition to the salary otherwise paid to them in the amount of \$750 per year, which shall be paid in one lump sum with the first full paid period in December of 2022.

**SECTION 5:** Persons appointed to specialists' positions designated in Sections 1 and 2 of this Resolution shall maintain their status in those positions until December 31, 2022, unless or until otherwise removed prior to that date by disciplinary action taken under personnel ordinances, or Village or Department rules and regulations.

**SECTION 6:** This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure by a concurrence of six members of Council, it being necessary to preserve the public peace, order, safety, health or welfare of the Village of Evendale, or to provide for the daily operations of a department or office of the Village of Evendale. It is necessary that this measure be put into immediate effect because the current specialist appointments expire December 31, 2022, and the new specialists need to be in place at the time of that expiration. Therefore, this resolution shall be effective upon passage.
