AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1612 OF THE CODIFIED ORIDNANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE REQUIRING COMPLIANCE WITH FIRE ALARMS

WHEREAS, Chapter 1612 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Evendale does not currently prohibit the unauthorized resetting or ignoring of a fire alarm; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief of the Village of Evendale has determined that the unauthorized resetting or ignoring of a fire alarm can create a public health risk; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief of the Village of Evendale has recommended that Chapter 1612 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Evendale be amended to prohibit the unauthorized resetting or ignoring of a fire alarm;

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE, STATE OF OHIO, six members concurring that:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> Chapter 1612 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Evendale is hereby amended to include Section 1612.07 Unauthorized Resetting or Ignoring of a Fire Alarm.

SECTION 2: Section 1612.07 hereby reads as follows:

1612.07 Unauthorized Resetting or Ignoring of a Fire Alarm

- a) No person shall silence, reset or otherwise disable in anyway a fire alarm in its normal state, or an alarm that has activated, without permission from the Fire Chief, Chief of the Bureau of Fire Prevention, or a duly authorized member of the Evendale Fire Department.
- b) No person shall ignore a fire alarm or notification of a fire condition or fail to evacuate the premises or area of alarm annunciation.
- c) Subsections (a) and (b) do not apply to: (a) certified alarm technicians working on an alarm or sprinkler system who may for maintenance or repair purposes disable an alarm, in whole or part, upon notifying the Evendale Fire Department. (b) One or two-family dwellings.

<u>SECTION 3:</u> This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from the earliest date allowed by law.

members of Council, it being necessary to preserve the public peace, order, safety, health or welfare of the Village of Evendale or to provide for the daily operation of a department or office of the Village of Evendale. It is necessary that this measure be put into immediate effect in order to ensure that the Village receives the benefit of the Fire EMS Mutual Aid Agreement as soon as possible in order to ensure adequate emergency services are available to the Village and its residents in time of need. WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of Evendale in Ordinance 95-100 established

departmental Imprest Petty Cash/Drawer Cash Fund for the Village of Evendale;

and

WHEREAS, In Ordinances 95-119, 96-22, 01-13, 02-66, 10-10 and 14-02 Council deleted

certain petty cash funds and established others; and

WHEREAS, funds are no longer necessary for the Fire Department –Petty Cash;

SECTION I

SECTION II

The Chief Fiscal and Accounting Officer is authorized to issue checks to the proper custodians to comply with Section 1 and upon receiving properly executed vouchers from various funds, reimburse said funds from time to maintain the balances at the levels indicated above.

SECTION III

The Chief Fiscal and Accounting Officer shall make an audit of these funds on or about the last business day each fiscal year. Random audits of one or more of these funds may be made at any time during a fiscal year.

SECTION IV

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure by a concurrence of six members of Council. The ordinance is an emergency necessary to preserve the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Evendale or to provide for the daily operation of a department or office of the Village. It is necessary that this measure be put into immediate effect because the public welfare and daily operations of the Village require that departments maintain their petty cash, drawer change and imprest funds and in order to meet the needs of the departments and offices involved and to service the needs of the public. Therefore this ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
