**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO HIRE
SEASONAL EMPLOYEES AND SETTING PAY RATES
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Evendale has enacted Chapter 260 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Evendale requiring authorization by Council for the Mayor to hire seasonal employees; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor has submitted a list of seasonal employees who may be employed for a particular season or seasons.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has fully complied with Section 260.06(a) of the Codified Ordinances of Evendale and recommended that Council authorize the hiring of the individuals specified below for seasonal positions for which employment is authorized by this ordinance.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE, STATE OF OHIO, six members concurring that:

SECTION 1: The following persons may be employed during a particular season or seasons by the Mayor of the Village of Evendale as Seasonal Employees at the hourly rate or lump sum rate established for each person by this Ordinance:

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO HIRE
GRACE NUNN AS THE PERMANENT PART-TIME CHILD
CARE ATTENDANT FOR THE RECREATION CENTER
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Evendale has enacted Chapter 260 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Evendale, requiring authorization by Council for the Mayor to hire a part-time employee; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended the hiring of Grace Nunn as a permanent part-time childcare attendant for Recreation Department; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the administration has fully complied with Section 260.06(a) of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Evendale; now

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE, STATE OF OHIO, six members concurring, that:

SECTION 1: The following person may be employed, effective May 2, 2016 by the Mayor of the Village of Evendale as a permanent part-time Childcare Attendant for the Recreation Department at an hourly rate established below:

Grace Nunn: Hourly Pay: \$9.09

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure by a concurrence of six members of the Village Council. The reason for said emergency is to preserve the public peace, order, safety, health or welfare of the Village of Evendale, or to provide for the daily operations of a department or office of the Village of Evendale. It is necessary that this measure be put into immediate effect in order to ensure that the Village Fire Department has the staffing necessary to provide for and to perform its critical functions to the Village and its citizens. Therefore, this ordinance shall be effective upon passage.

ORDINANCE #16-31**

AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING THE CONTRACT TO PURCHASE REAL ESTATE BETWEEN LANDMARK BAPTIST TEMPLE, INC., AN OHIO NON-PROFIT CORPORATION, AND THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Village of Evendale is interested in acquiring property currently owned by Landmark Baptist Temple, Inc., an Ohio non-profit corporation, located off of Glendale Milford Road adjacent to property already owned by the Village of Evendale; and

WHEREAS, Entering the contract holds the property under contract to the Village while the Village conducts its due diligence. The actual acquisition of the property will require further approval by Village Council; and

WHEREAS, To consummate the Contract to Purchase Real Estate and ensure the Village has the ability to conduct its due diligence, a \$10,000 earnest money deposit is required; now

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EVENDALE, STATE OF OHIO, six members concurring, that:

SECTION 1: The Contract to Purchase Real Estate, attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein between Landmark Baptist Temple, Inc., an Ohio non-profit corporation, and the Village of Evendale, Ohio is hereby ratified and the Mayor is authorized to execute such a contract substantially in that form.

SECTION 2: The Mayor is hereby authorized to provide a \$10,000 earnest money check to be deposited pursuant to the terms of the attached contract.

SECTION 3: The Village staff shall conduct or arrange for all due diligence necessary and appropriate and present the results of that due diligence to Council in a timely fashion so that Council may determine whether or not to proceed with the acquisition of the property.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure by a concurrence of six members of Council. The ordinance is an emergency necessary to preserve the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Evendale, or to provide for the daily operation of a department or office of the Village of Evendale. It is necessary that this measure be put into immediate effect so that Evendale may proceed pursuant to the contract ratified by this Ordinance and make the escrow payment provided for by that agreement in a timely fashion. Therefore, this Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
