Dear Neighbors and Friends,

Our Town Meeting this year will be in person on October 24th at 5:00p.m. Attendance and dinner may be restricted due to Covid regulations but we cannot be sure at this time. More about Town Meeting plans will be posted in upcoming newsletters.

Our Glendale-Milford Road bridge towers on I-75 are finished and they really stand out as we wanted them to. As I have said many times, we needed a prominent front door for the Village, AeroHub and our local businesses including our three world headquarters; GE Aviation, Formica and Gold Medal. The Ohio Department of Transportation already planned to replace the bridge; therefore, Council, recognizing this was a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity, approved an upgraded design in 2016 and appropriated money back then when funding was available. We are getting many kudos about the bridge enhancements and a few negatives. The "Thru the Valley" project continues.

Let's talk about 4th of July fireworks: In early April, myself and the Recreation Department had to decide whether or not to pay the \$30,000 fireworks fee. At that time, Hamilton County was designated a red "high COVID count" County. Consequently, the County Board of Health, State of Ohio and the CDC all discouraged large gatherings. Our fireworks display usually attracts about 5,000 people. These agencies told us that wearing masks would be required; however, from a practical perspective, it would be difficult to enforce this restriction. Also, no other events would occur like food, the Kids' Carnival, or inflatables. In the meantime, Blue Ash announced they will be hosting a fireworks-only event (no concert or traditional on-site experiences) with attendees confined to painted squares and required to wear masks. Only recently did the Governor's new order permit no masks, if vaccinated, for outdoor events. So, we checked with our fireworks provider to see if it was still possible to order and prepare a display for this year. Unfortunately, no dice. I hope you can understand our predicament.

Speaking of Village events, in awareness of societal security threats, Evendale has taken a proactive approach by forming a Task Force, headed by former councilmember John Ranz and consisting of staff and law enforcement professionals, to study and implement strategies to keep everyone as safe as possible during public events.

A few local employers have asked us to advertise their job openings in this newsletter. Since this newsletter has traditionally been meant to cover Village activity and events, we have contacted the Evendale Chamber of Commerce to see if they would consider advertising private job openings on their website.

Finally, the Ohio State Patrol will soon be doing targeted enforcement on I-75, including through Evendale, because some cars have recently been clocked in excess of 100mph.

ORD #21-29

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION IN THE AEROHUB TIF FUND FOR THE FIRE BRANCH WATER MAINS INSTALLATIONS AS PART OF THE AEROHUB PHASE 2 ROADWAY PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Unanimously approved

An emergency clause is frequently added to an ordinance in order to allow the ordinance or resolution to go into effect immediately upon adoption. Under Evendale's Charter, the emergency provision must be separately voted on and approved by no less than five members of Council. It must include a reason for why it is necessary .



SERVICE DEPARTMENT

Brush Chipping Regulations

All items to be chipped are to be at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on Monday morning.

Tree limbs and branches should be no larger than 8" in diameter.

Pile tree limbs neatly with the stalk end at the curb.

The following **CANNOT** be chipped: vines, garden waste, wood with nails or bushes with an excessive amount of dirt on roots. All vines and garden waste should be in bags for Rumpke pickup, not more than 50 pounds.

Please remove the root ball from trees and bushes for pickup.

It is the responsibility of the resident to have contractors, tree surgeons, landscapers, etc., remove their own materials and waste from the property.

REMINDER:

Grass clippings and leaves must be bagged and set out at the curb for pickup by Rumpke, not more than 50 pounds.


