The 4th of July event went very well. Those who attended were pleased to have the festivities back. Our new drone, used for parking/traffic and crowd safety monitoring, performed extremely well. It appeared that attendance was lower than past events, most likely because the holiday fell on a Monday and lots of people went away for a long weekend vacation. Also, COVID continues to be a concern for many people who are still avoiding crowds. Nonetheless, staff and I were very happy to see many residents, neighbors, and friends enjoying time together in celebration.

Thank you to the Service Department for recently painting the police garage, the tennis court restroom, and the service department buildings. The fresh coat of paint, on previously unpainted surfaces, helps improve the character of the whole Village campus.

The Aberdeen Trucking buildings on our AeroHub property is will soon be coming down. We have a grant from Hamilton County for about \$300,000 for tearing down the buildings and for re-grading the property in preparation for redevelopment. The grant covers approximately 55% of the total project costs. The project will be completed by December 31st of this year. AeroHub will certainly look better.

The demolition of Aberdeen left us with another problem; the Service Department currently uses the buildings for storage of some of their equipment. Fortunately, we have been working with a local company who has offered a vacated building on their property. We very much appreciate the positive relationships we have with our business community while and we work collectively to deliver high quality services to our businesses and residents.

So, as summer approaches the end, we hope you have enjoyed the warm weather, our pool, parks and recreational facilities. I can't believe summer is almost over!

- 5. There are a limited amount of bags available and are issued on a first come basis.




Schools are going back into session, and the Police Department would like to remind everyone of the rules when school buses are on the road.

When to stop for a school bus in Ohio

On a road with fewer than four lanes, all traffic approaching a stopped school bus from either direction must stop at least 10 feet from the front or rear of the bus and remain stopped until the bus begins to move or the bus driver signals motorists to proceed.









TWO-LANE HIGHWAY WITH CENTER TURN LANE

If the bus is stopped on a street with four or more lanes, only traffic proceeding in the same direction as the bus must stop.

Failure to stop for a school bus adds 2 points to your license in Ohio and is punishable by fines up to \$500. You must appear in court and the judge has the discretion to suspend your driver's license for up to one year. A driver who injures a pedestrian while failing to comply with school bus safety laws can face both criminal charges and civil liability. Those liabilities can include the victim's medical expenses, lost wages, rehabilitation, and non-economic damages, such as pain and suffering.



Athlete Training: Group or One-on-One


