Also, the Village built a \$3.5million recreation center as well as the new pool resulting in a complete change and upgrade to our municipal campus. Additionally, Mayor Apking helped bring the Boys Scouts of America to the Village who then built a beautiful new Center on Reading Rd. All of this was done without adding any debt to the Village. On a personal note, Don and his wife Sue were my neighbors when my wife and I first moved to the Village. We were all young and on very tight budgets; the builder of our homes only provided sod for the front and sides of our yards. Don, myself and others formed a bond and helped each other finish our backyards. Work was always followed by a party. Those bonds and friendships have lasted for many years. After I was elected to the Ohio Legislature, and before Don ran for Council, we were talking over the fence one day. He asked me how I could stand being in an elected position. Shortly after that conversation, Don ran for, and was elected, to Evendale Council. The rest is history! Thank you, Don, for all that you have done to advocate, grow and support the Village of Evendale.

In early February, we welcomed Mark Elma as the Village's new Building, Planning and Zoning Manager. Mark is a great addition to our administration team bringing more than 20 years of planning, zoning and community development experience. The Village also swore in new police and fire personnel, Officer Kaminsky and Firefighter/Paramedic Matthew Stelle. I'd like to thank both the Police and Fire Chief's for their diligence in recruiting and hiring these two quality professionals for these positions.

The Service Department did an excellent job keeping our roads clear during these recent snow and ice storms. Please offer a big high-five to the crews should you see them out and about.

On a sad note, both our Police Chief and Assistant Police Chief will be retiring later this year in June. Chief Korte and Assistant Chief Niehauser have done an excellent job leading our Police Department. More to come on that in the future. Fortunately, our Department consists of many professional, experienced officers with strong leadership skills and capacities.

SERVICE DEPARTMENT

Snow & Ice

During snow events, the policy of the Service Department is to concentrate on the main roads, especially hillsides and elevated surfaces. The neighborhood streets will be cleared and treated as soon as possible. Please remove all vehicles from public roadways in order for the crews to effectively clear the streets. Please understand the job of the snow crew is to clear the public roadways of snow/ice. The department is not responsible for clearing individual residential driveways/aprons, as this is the responsibility of the property owner. We make every effort to divert snow/ice away from driveways, but this is not entirely possible. The weekly chipper service will be suspended during snow operations to concentrate on public roadways. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation to allow us to perform this service.

Service Department Hiring Seasonal Employees

The Service Department is now accepting applications for Seasonal workers. Applications can be found online on the Village web site or picked up at the Service or Administration Departments.

TAX DEPARTMENT

Tax Forms - The 2021 Evendale Individual Income Tax Returns (Form IR) were mailed out on January 14, 2022. If you have not received your tax return, the forms are available on our website, evendaleohio.org/tax-department. The Due Date for filing your 2021 Evendale Income Tax Return, and paying the tax due, is **April 18, 2022**.

Work From Home - If you worked from home during the tax year 2021, and have requested a refund of local tax withheld by your employer for the work place city, the tax withheld by the employer and reported on Form W-2, must be reduced by the amount of the refund when computing the Evendale Credit for Tax Paid to Another Municipality (Line 5c of Form IR).

E-file/E-pay - The E-file system is available for most individuals to file their 2021 Evendale Individual Income Tax Return. You may access the system by visiting our website. An E-pay system is included as an option for paying the balance of tax due by credit card. A service fee is charged by the 3rd party credit card processor if utilizing E-Pay.

COVID-19 Impacts on Operations - Covid-19 continues to impact business operations. In-person taxpayer assistance remains suspended at this time. Taxpayer assistance is still available by telephone and by email.

Dropping off Information - If you need to visit our office to drop off tax information or to drop off your completed tax return, you may do so at the Administration Lobby window, M-F 8:00am to 4:00pm. You may also use the secured Tax Department Drop Box located in the Lobby of our Police Department after normal business hours. The Police Department Lobby is open 24/7.

In addition to this Scholarship Application and Essay we require that two (2) *Recommendation Forms* must be completed (no relatives), including one from current employer. These forms can be submitted with the application in a sealed envelope or the individuals completing them can email them to the Chamber. The essay and the scholarship application, along with the recommendation forms, must be received by April 1, 2022 for consideration.

We will base our selection on the following criteria, not necessarily in this order: Academics, Financial Need, Community Involvement, School Activities, Leadership Roles and others.

Finalists will be selected from those applications received and results announced on April 8, 2022.

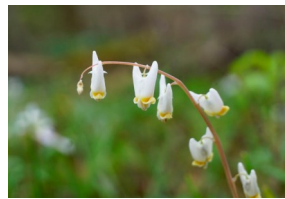

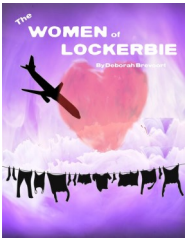
