

VILLAGE OF EVENDALE

Dear Neighbors and Friends,

We will begin with a request from the Service Department. As you know, Evendale offers curb pick up for most everything including the kitchen sink. This service occurs on Mondays; but people occasionally put stuff out on other days. Unless the Service Department sees the item, it can sit for several days. If you need to do that, please give them a call and advise. The Service Department thanks you.

Unfortunately, the Village has lost a lot of trees due to storms or old age. The Service Department recently removed several of these trees from our rights-of-way. You may have noticed the stumps. They will be replaced when trees become available. Right now, trees are hard to get due to supply chain problems. We also want the right type of replacement tree and we are doing research on that now.

Due to our improved financial condition, we are going to do about \$500,000 of deferred projects. However, the big need is for a storage building for our bigger equipment. You may have seen some of our equipment parked by the tennis courts. This equipment was stored at the former Aberdeen Trucking Co. building, now owned by the Village, on Glendale-Milford Road. But with the demolition of these buildings for site redevelopment as part of AeroHub, we now need new storage space. Temporary space has been made available to the Village at the former Boyd Bros. Trucking Co.; but, we do not know for how long it will be available. Stay tuned.

Kinetic Vision has occupied their new headquarters in AeroHub. The state-of-art building is drawing positive attention from a number of people. Kinetic Vision is a great asset for the Village.

The saga of the Cincinnati Police Gun Range continues. Hamilton County has offered to expand their existing Range in Colerain Township to accommodate Cincinnati and other local and state/federal law enforcement agencies, at a cost of around \$20 million. So far, the County has pledged \$5 million; and the City of Cincinnati has pledged \$2 million. Additionally, the County has secured an additional \$4 million in federal funds for the project, a \$9 million gap. We have asked the State legislature, the Governor, the Attorney General, etc. for funds. So far, there's been no progress in securing State funds this year. It looks like it will be 2023 before the project receives further state-level consideration.

We also had an excellent report from our State Auditor. Kudos to Cynthia Carraci, our chief fiscal officer, and to the entire administrative team for their solid fiscal stewardship. It is not easy to get a clean audit from the State.

Finally, Evendale was able to secure a new contract for gas supply for our Aggregation Program. AEP Energy has offered us a 24-month fixed rate of \$0.839 per ccf starting October 2022. Additional Program information will be posted on our Village website, <u>www.evendaleohio.org</u>. AEP will also mail information to all Evendale homes currently participating in the Program. Residents can enter or exit (aka "Opt-out") the voluntary program at any time with no fees or penalties.

RESIDENTIAL LEAF BAG POLICY

- Leaf bags will only be issued on Saturdays from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm and Wednesdays from 1:00 pm to 7:00 pm., at the Service Department. Limit 75 bags per household.
- For 2022 the dates will be: Saturday, September 24, October 1, 8, 15, 22 & 29 Wednesday, October 12 & 19
- 3. Each household will have to sign for the bags. (Proof of residency may be required)
- 4. You may only pick up the bags for your household.
- 5. There are a limited amount of bags available and are issued on a first come basis.

Leaf Bag Pick Up Reminder:

Rumpke requests residents to place leaf bags and waste containers in the same spot. <u>Bags must be less</u> than 50 pounds. Rumpke will only stop 1 time per house!

Special Pick Up Reminder:

All items out for Special Pickups need to be at the curb Sunday evening. Special pickups only happen on Mondays.

Brush Chipping Regulations

- All items to be chipped are to be at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on Monday morning.
- \bullet Tree limbs and branches should be no larger than 8" in diameter.
- Pile tree limbs neatly with the stalk end at the curb.
- The following **CANNOT** be chipped: vines, garden waste, wood with nails or bushes with an excessive amount of dirt on roots. All vines and garden waste should be in bags for Rumpke pickup, not more than 50 pounds.
- Please remove the root ball from trees and bushes for pickup.
- It is the responsibility of the resident to have contractors, tree surgeons, landscapers, etc., remove their own materials and waste from the property.


