Dear Neighbors and Friends,

First off this month, a bit of good news. The Cincinnati Cyclones, our regional minor league hockey team (playing in the East Coast Hockey League), has purchased Sports Plus for their practice facility. Additionally, it is our understanding that the facility will continue to be used for youth hockey development as well as for basketball tournaments. The Cyclones play home games downtown at the Heritage Bank Center; however, that venue also hosts other events, thus practice schedules are often interrupted. The Cyclones are a farm team of the NHL Buffalo Sabres. We welcome the Cyclones to Evendale and look forward to long term site improvements and positive community interactions.

The Charter Review Commission recently met and submitted a report to Council. In short, they recommended no amendments to the Charter. We considered one amendment; to allow online voting for Councilmembers who are unable to attend public meetings in person; but the Commission felt it was not wise at this time.

I participated in the "Call to Duty" event held at Landmark Church involving the 174th Air Defense Auxiliary Regiment stationed in Woodlawn. The Regiment will go to Washington D.C. for a year to operate the most sophisticated air defense in the country. Considering all the air traffic in and out of our nation's capital, this is a tough assignment.

For our new, on-campus Service Department building, we are using a newer construction management method called Construction Manager at Risk. The Village first issues a Request for Qualifications. Contractors then respond to a 3-person Village Committee who creates a list of valid contractors that is then submitted to Council for a final selection. Council can then enter into a contract to construct the new facility. A number of communities around us are using this system. It makes for a speedier time to get the project underway with a fixed project cost.

With the 4th of July soon upon us, please remember that private fireworks displays are still illegal in the Village. We chose to opt out of the State's relaxation of fireworks private displays. I encourage everyone to come to the Village fireworks event. It is a great party!

And with that, have a great 4th!!!

Brush Chipping Regulations

The Service Department reminds everyone it is the responsibility of the resident to have contractors, tree surgeons, landscapers, etc., remove their own materials and waste from the property.

- All items to be chipped are to be at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on Monday morning.
- Tree limbs and branches should be no larger than 8" in diameter.
- Pile tree limbs neatly with the stalk end at the curb.
- The following **CANNOT** be chipped: vines, garden waste, wood with nails or bushes with an excessive amount of dirt on roots. All vines and garden waste should be in bags for Rumpke pickup, not more than 50 pounds.
- Please remove the root ball from trees and bushes for pickup.

Stay Cool in the Summer Heat

Thank you to everyone who attended our annual Chili Lunch at the firehouse this June! The Evendale Fire Department would like to wish everyone a Happy Independence Day with a safety reminder and some medical advice as you enjoy your summer months.

As you enjoy your Independence Day celebrations, the fire department encourages you to keep the firework displays to the professionals. According to the National Fire Protection Agency, fireworks account for over 19,000 fires and 9,000 trips to the Emergency Room each year. Please forgo the home firework displays and enjoy the fantastic professional firework display at the Village Campus on July 4th.

While we settle into the heat of the summer, the Evendale Fire Department would like to remind you to stay cool and look out for these signs of a heat related emergency. Heat related emergencies can range from minor heat cramps to true medical emergencies such as heat stroke. As we are active in the summer heat, our body's mechanisms for maintaining its temperature can become overwhelmed and the following signs and symptoms can develop heavy, excessive sweating accompanied by painful muscle cramps and spasms could be the result of heat cramps. Heat cramps are a

minor heat illness that often can be resolved with hydration and resting in a cool, indoor environment. Heat cramps, if left unresolved, can lead to heat exhaustion, a more serious heat illness. Heat exhaustion often presents with cool, pale, clammy skin, dizziness, weakness, nausea and vomiting, along with excessive sweating. If these symptoms are present and taking measures such as moving to a cool environment and hydrating does not relieve them, we recommend that you call 911 so we can help provide medical treatment. It is important to recognize these signs and symptoms as early as possible as they can lead to heat stroke, a true medical emergency. Heat stroke is a late stage of heat illness that will present with hot, red, dry skin, nausea and vomiting, elevated body temperature (103° F), confusion, or even loss of consciousness. If heat stroke is present it is imperative that someone call 911 and move the individual to a cool environment, apply cold water to their body, and do not give them liquids to drink. Please remember these signs and symptoms during these hot months as early recognition is key to receiving proper cooling mechanisms and potential medical care. Stay cool and hydrate this summer to reduce your risk of heat related emergencies!

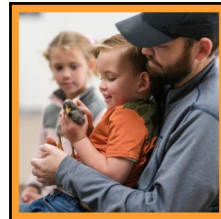
