Dear Neighbors and Friends,

The finances of the State of Ohio are doing very well. Also, Ohio's unemployment was down to 4.2% as of December 2023. With continued local business growth and expansion, Evendale's finances are doing well too. We finished 2023 with \$17.8 million in earnings tax, our highest annual amount ever collected. Evendale also earned over \$1 million on our investments. Additionally, the bond rating for the Village is AA, the highest it has been in 42 years. These are all signs of more positive things to come in 2024 and beyond.

Evendale has two big capital projects scheduled 2024: 1) An elevator for the Cultural Arts Center; and, 2) a storage facility for our Service Department. Both projects are expensive and will take time to complete. However, both projects are needed and will help the Village better serve our residents, businesses and visitors.

Joe Wathen, a long-time Village resident, passed away in December. Joe served on Council for 12 years and also served as Chair of the Planning and Zoning Commission. He was of great service to our community.

Jeff Albrinck, our recently retired Council member, has been nominated to be on the Board of the Millcreek Valley Conservancy District. His nomination now goes to Judge Jody Luebbers for the final appointment. He will be an excellent addition to that three-person Board. The District controls more property in Evendale and Sharonville than any other community along the Millcreek. As I have said before, the Millcreek requires constant attention and floodplain maintenance. Neglecting the Creek could cost millions in private property damage and environmental problems throughout Hamilton and Butler Counties; therefore, the Commission needs strong leadership to make important decisions about protecting the Creek and the properties that surround it.

Our Service Department is prepared for any more wintery weather that may affect our streets. We have ample salt supply on hand if needed.

TAX DEPARTMENT



Tax Forms - The 2023 Evendale Individual Income Tax Returns (Form IR) were mailed on January 12, 2024. If you have not received your return, please contact the Tax Department. The 2023 Tax Forms are also available on our website, https://www.evendaleohio.org/tax-department and in the lobby of the Administration Department. The due date for filing your 2023 Evendale Individual Income Tax return and for paying the tax due is April 15, 2024.

E-file/E-pay – The E-file system is available for most individuals to file their 2023 Evendale Individual Income Tax Return. An E-pay system is included with the E-file system, allowing for payment of the balance of tax due by credit card. The E-file system may be accessed by visiting our website at https://www.evendaleohio.org/tax-department. Credit card payments will be accepted without assessment of a convenience fee by the 3rd party credit card processor (some restrictions may apply). VISA, MasterCard and Discover are accepted.

NEW THIS YEAR – You may also make an online tax payment by credit card at any time, even if you are not filing your tax return via the E-file system. Visit our website at https://www.evendaleohio.org/tax-department and select "Make a Tax Payment Online". Credit card payments will be accepted without assessment of a convenience fee by the 3rd party credit card processor (some restrictions may apply). VISA, MasterCard and Discover are accepted.

Work From Home - If you requested a refund from your work place city for the tax year 2023 because you worked from home, your resident credit for Tax Paid to Another Municipality (Evendale Individual Income Tax Return, Line 5c) must be reduced for the refund received from your work place city.

Taxpayer Assistance – In-person taxpayer assistance remains by appointment only at this time. Taxpayer assistance is also available by telephone and by email.

Dropping off Tax Information - If you need to visit our office to drop off tax return information or to drop off your completed tax return, you may do so at the Administration Lobby window, M-F 8:00am to 4:00pm. After normal business hours, you may also use the secured Tax Department Drop Box located in the Lobby of our Police Department. The Police Department Lobby is open 24/7.
