

2015 Evendale Men's Golf League

League play starts on Monday, April 20 and Wed. April 22 and ends on August 24, 2015.

League Banquets will be held individually again this year. Secretaries will determine date and location. Recreation Department will give secretaries money towards the event.

Please show up early for all matches if you can. Remember if you are late you may be holding up 3 other players. If you cannot play please call your partner.

Each player is responsible for obtaining a sub when he cannot show up for league play. The league has a sub list and you can arrange for a sub from that list, or you can have your own sub play for you.

PURPOSE-The purpose of this league is to get the men of Evendale playing golf, with exercise, good sportsmanship and fair play as its objective. The name of the game is RELAX.

LEAGUE- There will be three divisions this year. One division will play at the Beckett Ridge. Another division will play at Green Crest Golf Course rotating front and back. The third division will play at Glenview between the three nines. The Glenview division plays on Wednesdays, Green Crest and Beckett Ridge on Mondays.

STARTING TIME AT GREEN CREST IS 4:26 PM. LAST TIME IS 5:16 PM.

STARTING TIME AT BECKETT RIDGE IS 5:10 PM. LAST TIME IS 5:34 PM.

STARTING TIME AT GLENVIEW IS 5:10 PM. LAST TIME IS 5:48 PM.

FEES Each golfer pays a \$30.00 league fee to the Recreation Department. If you play in two divisions the fee is \$50. This fee covers the banquet at the end of the season, prizes, gift certificates and secretaries' fees.

AVERAGE SCORE AND HANDICAPPING

AVERAGES

A combination of the 2014 and 2015 scores will be used until five 2015 scores are recorded, as follows:

1st Week - average of all scores from 2014 (e.g. 40) = 40.0 average

2nd Week - shoot 38, plus four 40's = 198; $198/5 = 39.6$ average

3rd Week - shoot 43 + 38 + three 40's = 201; $201/5 = 40.2$ average

4th Week - shoot 47 + 43 + 38 + two 40's = 208; $208/5 = 41.6$ average

5th Week - shoot 42 + 47 + 43 + 38 + 40 = 210; $210/5 = 42.0$ average

The lowest five 2015 scores are used after 5 scores are recorded

SUBSTITUTE INFO & AVERAGE – Substitutes pay \$5 per round to golf secretaries. Subs must also be at least 16 years of age or older. New subs must use the score they shoot that day as their handicap. Each round a new player pays (until he gets 5 rounds in) is averaged with his previous rounds to calculate the handicap. From then on out we use his 5 lowest scores. If a sub played 5 times last year, that average is used. If a sub played less than 5 times, they will need to start fresh in the current year.

Closest to the Pin

Closest to the Pin money will be collected on the first night of play. Secretaries determine the amount.

League Specific

Reasonable rules may be set for each league by secretaries at each course.

PLAY AND SCORING

PLAY - Team and individual play will be on a 22 point system.

- A) Match play for 9 holes using 85% handicap. One point per hole - total 9 points.
- B) Medal play - gross score less handicap for the final 2 points. Match opponents - in all matches, low average man plays low average man.

NO SHOW SCORING

- A) When only 3 golfers show up, the single player plays full match against lowest handicap opponent. The second opponent receives an automatic two points medal and at least four match points. In this match the single players can only keep the second opponent from scoring more than 4 match points.
- B) When only 1 golfer from each team shows up they will play full match - max 11 points only. Single score only.
- C) When only 2 players from same team show they will receive as many as highest score that night. This includes rain no shows.
- D) When only 1 player shows in foursome that team will receive half as many points as any team scores that night.

OUT OF BOUNDS - If your first ball goes out of bounds, lay out two (2) club lengths from the out of bounds stakes or marker. Penalty ONE (1) STROKE. After hitting ball in a lake lay out across the lake with one stroke penalty. On holes with lateral water hazards, lay out two club lengths from the hazard line no nearer the hole, penalty ONE (1) STROKE.

LOST BALL - A ball should be dropped in the location of the lost ball. Penalty ONE (1) STROKE.

IMPROVED LIE - You may improve your lie in the fairway, the rough or in the other fairway with the head of your club. You MAY NOT improve your lie in a sand trap.

SCORE CARDS - Each team is responsible for turning in its score cards completely filled out showing total score, points won and points lost. IF THE CARDS ARE NOT FILLED OUT COMPLETELY YOU WILL FORFEIT POINTS.

RAIN

All golfers must report to the Golf Course. Round is not canceled unless the course is closed. If round is played and your team does not show, your team will lose by forfeit. In case of inclement weather all must finish or round does not count. If it rains during play take cover but DO NOT LEAVE the course or club house without checking with the league secretary to see if the round is canceled. You may lose your match if play continues. (See No Show scoring previous page.)

CHAMPIONSHIP

The league winners from each division, Green Crest, Beckett Ridge and Glenview will be the secretaries the following year, will receive half of their golf fees paid the following season.

Last night of competition play will be determined by the secretaries. Players must play at least 2 weeks to be eligible for this competition.

PRIZES

Prizes will be given out by the league secretaries. A specified dollar amount per golfer will be given to the secretaries/course to be used for end of season banquet and prizes.
